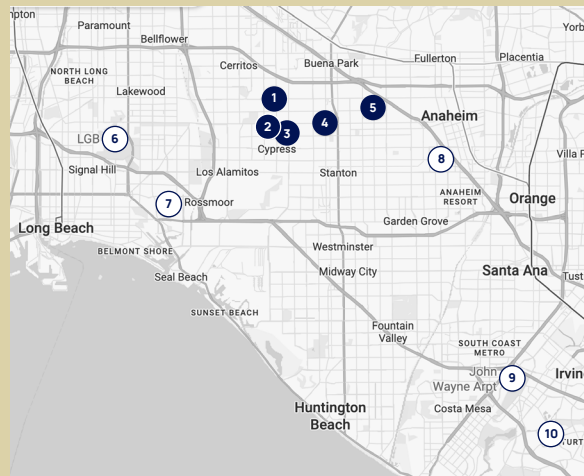

OXFORD ACADEMY
