A challenging curriculum with a holistic, student-centered approach

All students accepted to Fenwick are expected to meet the challenges of College Prep courses, which is the standard level of instruction. For students needing more support, a modified form of College Prep known as **College Prep 1 (CP1)** is offered, which focuses on the reinforcement of study skills and habits. Higher level honors courses are also available in all subjects. Students are placed at the level best suited to their ability, as determined by the teachers' assessments of their performance. CP1, College Prep, and Honors levels of the same course will address the same content, while pace, depth, and rigor vary according to the ability of each group. There are also **18+ AP courses** offered to further challenge advanced students.

Special courses that go beyond the standard department curricula

- **Fenwick's Peer Leadership** is a half-credit program for seniors, equipping them to be role models so they can mentor freshmen on academic concerns, relationships, peer pressure, and conflict resolution.
- **Introduction to Entrepreneurship and Leadership** is a full-credit offering for business-minded students. They will develop real-world professional skills in competence, innovation, integrity, and teamwork.
- **Virtual High School (VHS)** has partnered with Fenwick for more than 20 years to expand and enrich elective course offerings to independently motivated juniors and seniors.

Robust arts offerings to foster creativity

Every freshman kicks off their Fenwick journey with a full year of semester-long arts courses, giving them the chance to discover new talents and dive into different creative outlets. Fenwick artists rank at the top of the state in winning **Boston Globe All Scholastic Awards**, thespians perform in multiple productions—both plays and musicals—each year in our 1,000+ capacity theatre, and the Concert Choir travels for performances to locations such as **Carnegie Hall** and **Disney World**.

Competitive and accomplished athletics program

Fenwick has achieved decades of athletic success, including numerous league, sectional, and state championships. The Crusaders compete in 28 interscholastic sports at a variety of levels, and 22 of these sports play all of their home competitions on Fenwick's 59-acre campus. Over 80% of the student body participates in at least one sport during their four years, and on average, more than 20% of graduating classes continue their athletic careers at colleges and universities across the country.

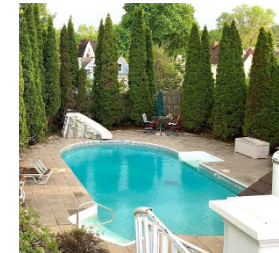
