



A challenging curriculum with a holistic, student-centered approach

- All students accepted to Fenwick are placed at the academic level best suited to their ability, with the College Prep level being the standard level of instruction.
- For students needing more support, a modified form of College Prep known as **College Prep 1 (CP1)** is offered, which focuses on the reinforcement of study skills and habits. Honors-level courses are also available in all subjects.
- CP1, College Prep, and Honors levels of the same course will address the same content, while pace, depth, and rigor vary according to the ability of each group. There are also **18+ AP courses** offered to further challenge advanced students.



Special courses that go beyond the standard department curricula

- **Fenwick's Peer Leadership** is a half-credit program for seniors, equipping them to be role models so they can mentor freshmen on academic concerns, relationships, peer pressure, and conflict resolution.
- **Introduction to Entrepreneurship and Leadership** is a full-credit offering for business-minded students. They will develop real-world professional skills in competence, innovation, integrity, and teamwork.
- **Virtual High School (VHS)** has partnered with Fenwick for more than 20 years to expand and enrich elective course offerings to independently motivated juniors and seniors.




Robust arts offerings to foster creativity

- Every freshman kicks off their Fenwick journey with a full year of semester-long arts courses to dive into different creative outlets.
- Fenwick artists rank at the top of the state in winning **Boston Globe All Scholastic Awards**, thespians perform in multiple productions-both plays and musicals-each year in our 1,000+ capacity theatre, and the Concert Choir travels for performances to locations such as **Carnegie Hall and Disney World**.
- Student artists are accepted to leading colleges such as **Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD)** and **Rhode Island School of Design (RISD)**.

Rigorous college preparatory education

- At Fenwick, college planning spans all 4 years. **The College Counseling Department** works throughout the year to support students and families by hosting events like Financial Aid Nights, inviting college representatives to campus, and a career speaker series to help students explore potential vocations.
- **The College and Career Seminar** is required of all juniors, providing an opportunity beyond individual counseling to meet routinely with their school and college counselor in a classroom setting to explore future plans.
- With proximity to world-renowned universities like **MIT, Harvard and Boston University**, Fenwick offers students both inspiration and opportunities for building early connections.


