Brentwood School offers a modern, future-focused academic experience, combining traditional excellence with innovative teaching. Students benefit from a broad curriculum with three clearly defined Sixth Form pathways: **A Levels, the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, and the BTEC Extended Diploma in Business or Sport.**

This flexibility allows students to pursue learning based on strengths, interests, and university goals, while receiving strong academic guidance and support throughout their studies. For Class of 2025, **56.7% of A Level results at A*-A (2025) and 86.7% of A Level results at A*-B.**

Arts & Sports

Brentwood offers outstanding Arts and Sports programs supported by professional studios, rehearsal spaces, and performance venues, including the **400-seat Wessex Auditorium**. It is **one of only 12 All-Steinway Schools in the UK**, demonstrating their full commitment to excellence by providing their students and faculties with the best instruments possible for the study of music.

Sport is a major strength, with **75 acres of playing fields** and a state-of-the-art sports center featuring a **25-metre pool**, fencing salle, squash courts, and facilities used by **Team GB** ahead of the London Olympics.

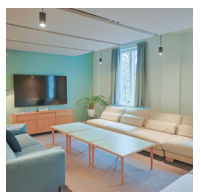


Boarding Program
