Saint Francis Hospital Medical Education Lab

The Saint Francis Hospital Medical Education Lab at Saint Anthony's is the first program of its kind in New York State, providing students with unparalleled exposure to state-of-the-art equipment, services and medical care. St. Anthony's partners with the Saint Francis Hospital and offers a Medical Education Lab to all students. The students utilize the most advanced medical education tool.

Anatomage Table

Only 40 high schools in the US offer students an Anatomage Table, which is used for anatomy visualization and digital dissection.

The Innovation Center

The Innovation Center is an advanced STEM lab where students take part in hands-on learning.



Advanced Business Program

Saint Anthony's business courses provide students with real-life training and marketable skills. Students have the option to receive university credit for their business coursework.

Business & Entrepreneurship Center

Our comprehensive academic support for Grade 12 students includes:

- Enrollment in prerequisite courses through Catholic Virtual High School (CVHS)

Admission Requirements:

- **Academic Requirements:** Minimum GPA 2.5 (or 2.0 if repeating)
- **English Proficiency:** 650+
- **No F Policy:** 1–2 Fs may be considered (must repeat courses)
- **No D Policy:** Ds may be considered (must repeat courses)
- **Skipping HS Grade:** Not allowed
- **Repeating Grade:** Allowed
- **Transcripts:** 2 previous years + Semester 1 of current year/progress report
- **LOR:** Not required
- **Graduation Age:** Under 21
- **Decision Time:** 3–5 business days (up to 10 for non-standard cases)



Art Course

St. Anthony's offers a robust Fine Arts Program where students can follow their passions through practicing, crafting, creating, presenting and performing their work, whether vocal, instrumental, visual or theatrical.

Vocal, Instrumental and Performing Arts

The chorus at St. Anthony's is the largest high school chorus in the entire USA. With more than 500 members, students perform a Christmas Concert in December and a Spring Concert in May.

Visual Arts

Studio in Art students complete basic assignments such as still life and perspective drawings. Artists in advanced level classes complete more intricate pieces involving watercolor and oil painting. Ceramic students work for months perfecting their statues, vases and bowls. Students in the Art Program develop very elaborate and masterful portfolios showcasing their many creations. Each year, the Art Department features a Winter Art Show and a Spring Art Show to display our students' many creations.

- Located In The Same Complex As A Starbucks, A Bubble Tea Shop, A Chinese Restaurant

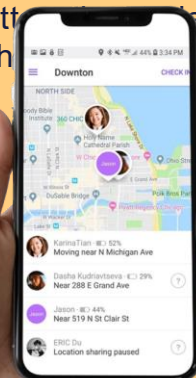

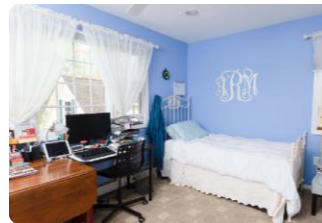
Homestay

At St. Anthony's High School, international students who choose to live in Homestay not only get a great education, they also find loving homes and create lasting relationships with their host families.

Homestay family selection process

Safety is always the *#1 priority* for our students. All host families undergo a rigorous application and screening process to ensure they are a good candidate to host. This includes:

- A comprehensive application
- Background check for every adult in the home
- An interview
- An in-person home check by an international staff team member
- Matching to student interest forms to ensure a good fit for both student and host (completed after acceptance into program)



Life in a Homestay

- Students live in safe, comfortable homestays in close proximity to the school
- Students have comfortable bedrooms, including a dresser, bed, desk and closet
- Host families and students are paired through methodical matching process
- Regular acculturation activities are offered through both the host family and the school
- Our international team is in constant communication with families, including receiving monthly reports
- 24/7 team is available for emergency assistance or urgent issues
- The host family offers a full-time English language environment
- Hosts provide transportation to and from the school every day
- Family provides healthy meals every day

Open Grades for Applications: 9-11 | Grade 12 on a case-by-case basis

Language Requirement:

- Accepted Tests: TOEFL iBT, IELTS, Duolingo, ELTiS
- Minimum Score: ELTiS 650+

Application Materials:

- 2 Years of Transcripts and the progress report for the current year
- English and Math Recommendation Letters
- Passport
