5.5 million children are enrolled in Medi-Cal, which is **53%** of all Californians under **age 21.**¹

40% of births are covered by Medi-Cal, helping kids get a healthy start.

Medi-Cal, California's Medicaid program, provides needed health care services for families with children, persons with disabilities, children in foster care, pregnant women and people with specific diseases.

States report estimated expenditures to Medicaid and the federal government provides matching funds.





Medi-Cal providers get paid with a combination of federal and state funds.


