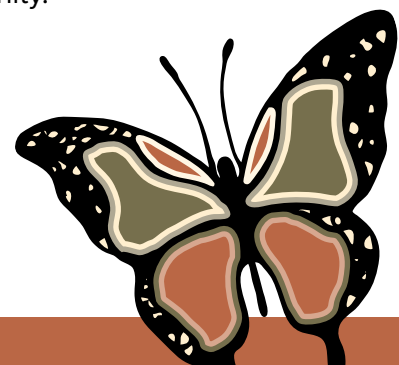
Bring Your Nursing Dreams to Life

- Mature Student Assessment
- General Education Development (GED)
- Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) credits

Other Courses Required:

- Grade 11 Mathematics** or Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) Core Math (UM602)
- Grade 11 or 12 Biology**
- Grade 11 or 12 Chemistry**

International Students:

- High school diploma with Grade 12 Math, Biology, and Chemistry
- Original and translated transcripts (if applicable)

Alternative Pathway:

Pre-Health Sciences – Pathway to Certificates and Diplomas (does not guarantee admission to the Practical Nursing program in a subsequent year).

Other Requirements:

- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector check (CRC-VS)
- First Aid & CPR HCP
- Mask fit testing
- Two-step TB test
- WHMIS
- Immunization record: Serology for Hep B; Measles, Mumps, & Rubella; Varicella (if any are nonreactive, then boosters are required), Influenza, COVID-19 plus booster
