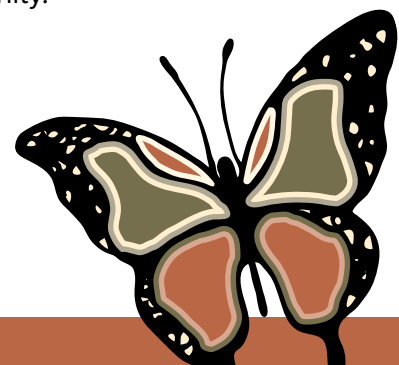

2-Year Diploma Program (5 continuous semesters)

Program Requirements (for domestic students):

1. Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) with courses from the College (C), University (U), University/College (U/C), or Open (O) preparation levels **with** Grade 12 English (C/U) Level.
2. **or** successful completion of the Mature Student Assessment.
3. **or** successful completion of the Canadian Adult Education Credential (CAEC) or General Education Development Test (GED), prior to May 2024.
4. **or** appropriate credits from the Academic and Career Entrance program (ACE).

Other Courses Recommended:

1. Grade 11 Mathematics (College or University Preparation) **or** ACE Core Math (UM602) &
2. Grade 11 **or** 12 Biology (College or University Preparation) &
3. Grade 11 **or** 12 Chemistry (College or University Preparation)

Other Requirements:

- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector check (CRC-VS)
- First Aid & CPR HCP
- Mask fit testing
- Two-step TB test
- WHMIS
- Immunization record: Serology for Hep B; Measles, Mumps, & Rubella; Varicella (if any are nonreactive, then boosters are required), Influenza, COVID-19 plus booster
