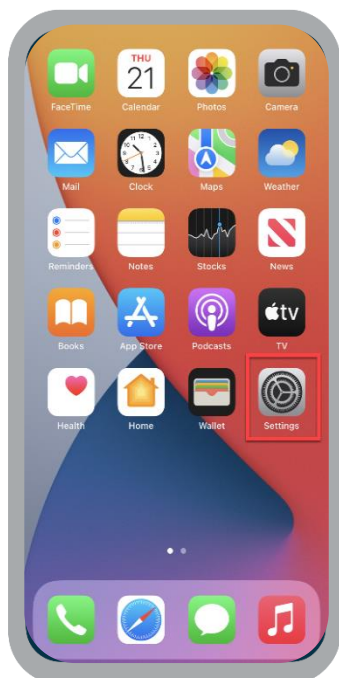


Turning your iPhone into a WiFi hotspot

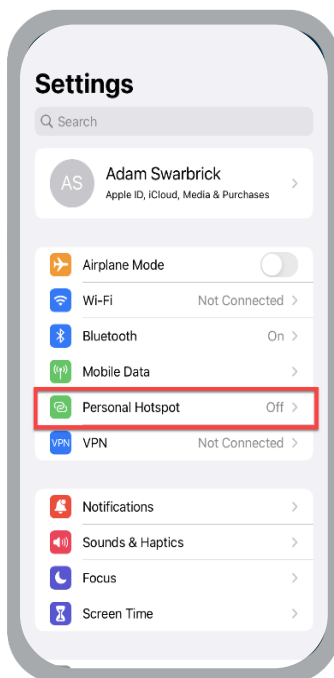
With your iPhone's personal hotspot activated, you will be able to connect your laptop (or other device) to your mobile network. Please be aware that the connection speed will depend entirely on the signal strength of your mobile device, and also that leaving this function turned on will significantly reduce your battery life.

Note: iPhone SE and the iPhone 11 are only capable of 4G network speeds, 5G is supported from the iPhone 12 onwards

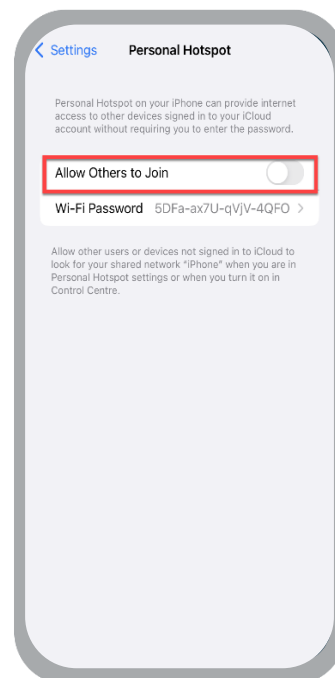
1. Tap **Settings**



2. Tap **Personal Hotspot**

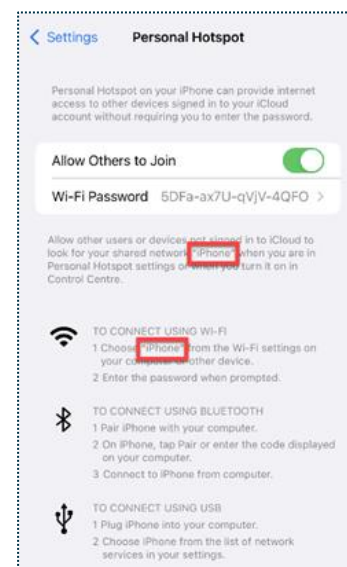


3. Tap **Allow Others to Join**



Your iPhone is now set up as a WiFi hotspot, and you can connect your laptop to your phone as you would connect to any wireless network.

The password necessary to connect will be generated for you. You can tap on this password to change it. If you do change your password, please ensure that you include upper/lower case letters, special characters and/or numbers to maintain complexity.
