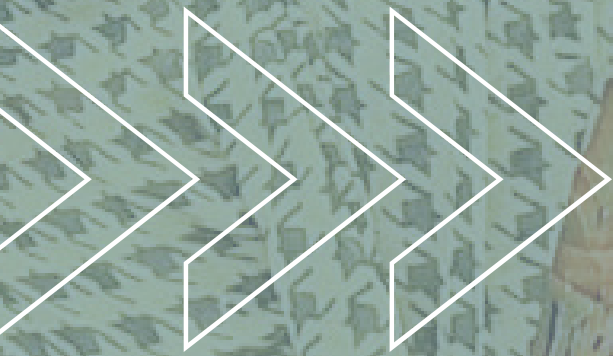

Engaging in Prayer for Frontline Missions



Saying ‘YES’ to the great commission as you pray

The great commission is a command given to the church by Jesus; in fact it was his final command to us. When he commissioned us to make disciples in all nations (people groups), he guaranteed we would see this come to fruition through the picture painted in Revelation of every tribe, tongue, people and nation worshipping Jesus around the throne of God.

We can walk in faith-filled obedience to Jesus’ commission by praying according to God’s desire to send laborers and work salvation among those who haven’t heard the gospel preached to them yet.

Engaging in this call to pray doesn’t have to be complicated. Use this guide to know what to pray and then find creative ways to regularly pray that God’s light would pierce the darkest corners of the globe. Here are some ideas to get you started!



Home Routines



Put the prayer guide on your fridge or mirror & use normal routine times like laundry, cooking, dishes or getting ready to pray for frontline teams.

Small Groups



Adopt a region as a small group & incorporate a time of prayer to consistently pray for God to work salvation through the teams laboring in that region.

With a Friend



Set a weekly coffee & prayer date with a friend. It can be as easy as picking up the phone or meeting for a walk. Join together to pray to the Lord of the harvest.

As a Family



Use dinner time to disciple your kids & impact the nations. Teach them about God's will for every tribe to know him & then pray together for the unreached & our frontline teams.



Praying for the Uganda Mission Base

The Prayer Center

The prayer center at the Uganda base has become a gathering place for worship, unity, and spiritual renewal among churches, missionaries, and students. Throughout the year, the base hosts worship gatherings, conferences, and times of intercession that strengthen believers and stir fresh passion for missions across the region. ***PRAY: Spiritual renewal across the region; unity among churches and missionaries; continued hunger for worship and prayer.***

Mission and Prayer School

The Uganda MAPS program continues to train and equip missionaries through biblical teaching, outreach, discipleship, and prayer. Students are actively engaged in ministry while being discipled in spiritual maturity and leadership. Over the years, the program has helped launch African missionaries serving throughout East Africa. ***PRAY: Growth and maturity among students; wisdom for teachers and leaders; more laborers raised up for the harvest.***

The Team

The Uganda base team is largely led and operated by Ugandan pastors, teachers, missionaries, and staff serving in a variety of roles. Some lead outreach and discipleship, while others teach in MAPS, care for children, serve in the prayer center, or support missionaries on the field. Through ministries like Lydia Rose Children's Ministry, the team is seeing entire families impacted, including children from Muslim backgrounds coming to Christ and being baptized. ***PRAY: Strength and unity for the team; continued fruit through children's ministry and discipleship; wisdom as they train and send missionaries.***
