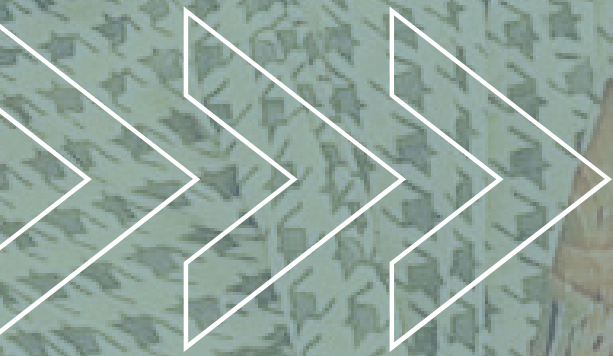

Engaging in Prayer for Frontline Missions



Saying ‘YES’ to the great commission as you pray

The great commission is a command given to the church by Jesus; in fact it was his final command to us. When he commissioned us to make disciples in all nations (people groups), he guaranteed we would see this come to fruition through the picture painted in Revelation of every tribe, tongue, people and nation worshipping Jesus around the throne of God.

We can walk in faith-filled obedience to Jesus’ commission by praying according to God’s desire to send laborers and work salvation among those who haven’t heard the gospel preached to them yet.

Engaging in this call to pray doesn’t have to be complicated. Use this guide to know what to pray and then find creative ways to regularly pray that God’s light would pierce the darkest corners of the globe. Here are some ideas to get you started!



Home Routines



Put the prayer guide on your fridge or mirror & use normal routine times like laundry, cooking, dishes or getting ready to pray for frontline teams.

Small Groups



Adopt a region as a small group & incorporate a time of prayer to consistently pray for God to work salvation through the teams laboring in that region.

With a Friend



Set a weekly coffee & prayer date with a friend. It can be as easy as picking up the phone or meeting for a walk. Join together to pray to the Lord of the harvest.

As a Family



Use dinner time to disciple your kids & impact the nations. Teach them about God's will for every tribe to know him & then pray together for the unreached & our frontline teams.



Praying for the Nigeria Mission Base

The Prayer Center

The prayer center at the Nigeria base has become a place of worship, intercession, and encouragement in the midst of a region marked by persecution and instability. Through regional prayer conferences, worship gatherings, and times of united prayer, believers are being strengthened and stirred toward missions across northern Nigeria and beyond. **PRAY: Endurance and faith for believers facing persecution; unity among churches; continued revival and hunger for prayer.**

Mission and Prayer School

The Nigeria MAPS program is training and sending missionaries into some of the least reached areas of West Africa. Students are equipped through biblical teaching, outreach, discipleship, and prayer, preparing them to minister among Muslim communities and unreached people groups. The school has already begun launching missionaries into new mission fields across northern Nigeria. **PRAY: Boldness and perseverance among students; protection for missionaries being sent out; continued multiplication across West Africa.**

The Team

The Nigeria base team serves through outreach, discipleship, relief work, teaching, and prayer ministry. In the wake of ongoing violence, the team has helped rebuild churches and homes while continuing to bring practical support and the hope of the gospel to affected communities. Through conferences, outreach, and creative projects, the base continues strengthening both local churches and frontline missionaries. **PRAY: Wisdom and protection for the team; provision for outreach and relief efforts; continued fruit in discipleship and church strengthening.**
