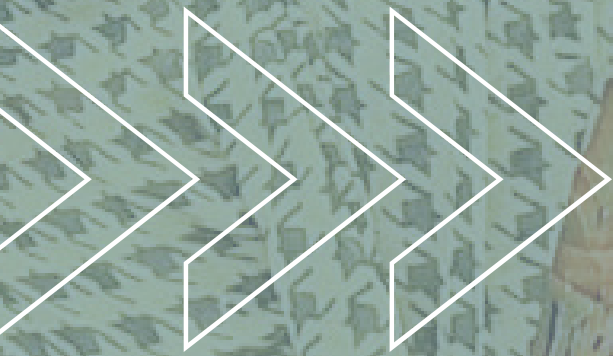

Engaging in Prayer for Frontline Missions



Saying ‘YES’ to the great commission as you pray

The great commission is a command given to the church by Jesus; in fact it was his final command to us. When he commissioned us to make disciples in all nations (people groups), he guaranteed we would see this come to fruition through the picture painted in Revelation of every tribe, tongue, people and nation worshipping Jesus around the throne of God.

We can walk in faith-filled obedience to Jesus’ commission by praying according to God’s desire to send laborers and work salvation among those who haven’t heard the gospel preached to them yet.

Engaging in this call to pray doesn’t have to be complicated. Use this guide to know what to pray and then find creative ways to regularly pray that God’s light would pierce the darkest corners of the globe. Here are some ideas to get you started!



Home Routines

Small Groups

As a Family



Use dinner time to disciple your kids & impact the nations. Teach them about God's will for every tribe to know him & then pray together for the unreached & our frontline teams.



Praying for the Kenya Mission Base

The Prayer Center

The prayer center at the Kenya base serves as a place of daily worship, prayer, and spiritual formation for students, missionaries, and local believers. Through regular prayer gatherings and outreach focused intercession, the base continues cultivating a heart for missions and dependence on the Lord. **PRAY: Fresh passion for prayer and missions; spiritual growth among students and staff; unity within the base community.**

Mission and Prayer School

The Kenya MAPS program trains students through biblical teaching, discipleship, outreach, and practical ministry experience. Throughout the year, students regularly engage in evangelism, including ministry in predominantly Muslim areas, helping them grow in boldness and confidence as they prepare for long term mission work. **PRAY: Boldness and maturity among students; wisdom for leaders and teachers; more missionaries raised up for unreached peoples.**

The Team

The Kenya base team serves through outreach, discipleship, teaching, pastoral care, and community support. In addition to training missionaries, the team responds to practical needs through medical assistance, food support, and short term outreach efforts. As leadership continues to grow and develop, the base remains focused on strengthening missionaries and expanding gospel access throughout the region. **PRAY: Strength and unity for the team; wisdom for leadership; continued fruit through outreach and pastoral care.**
