Engaging in Prayer for Frontline Missions



Saying ‘YES’ to the great commission as you pray

The great commission is a command given to the church by Jesus; in fact it was his final command to us. When he commissioned us to make disciples in all nations (people groups), he guaranteed we would see this come to fruition through the picture painted in Revelation of every tribe, tongue, people and nation worshipping Jesus around the throne of God.

We can walk in faith-filled obedience to Jesus’ commission by praying according to God’s desire to send laborers and work salvation among those who haven’t heard the gospel preached to them yet.

Engaging in this call to pray doesn’t have to be complicated. Use this guide to know what to pray and then find creative ways to regularly pray that God’s light would pierce the darkest corners of the globe. Here are some ideas to get you started!



Home Routines



Put the prayer guide on your fridge or mirror & use normal routine times like laundry, cooking, dishes or getting ready to pray for frontline teams.

Small Groups



Adopt a region as a small group & incorporate a time of prayer to consistently pray for God to work salvation through the teams laboring in that region.

With a Friend



Set a weekly coffee & prayer date with a friend. It can be as easy as picking up the phone or meeting for a walk. Join together to pray to the Lord of the harvest.

As a Family



Use dinner time to disciple your kids & impact the nations. Teach them about God's will for every tribe to know him & then pray together for the unreached & our frontline teams.



Praying for the Nuba Mountains Team

The Region

The Nuba Mountains of Sudan are a remote and isolated region marked by over 40 years of conflict and almost no infrastructure—few roads, schools, or basic services. Dozens of tribes live scattered across the mountains, many unreached with the gospel. Ongoing violence has forced many to flee into refugee camps in South Sudan, where entire communities now live in harsh conditions. Yet in the midst of displacement, there is surprising openness to the gospel as many search for hope. **PRAY: Access to remote and displaced communities; stability for those living in refugee conditions; continued openness to the gospel.**

The Unreached Tribe

The Nuba region is home to many distinct tribes, including the Shatt, Trawi, Shwai, Wali, Daloka, Ngile, and Nubian peoples. Most have little to no gospel presence, and many come from Muslim or mixed religious backgrounds shaped by years of conflict and survival. While access has been limited, those who encounter the gospel often carry it back to their own people, creating a unique opportunity for multiplication across tribes. **PRAY: Gospel access among unreached tribes; local believers equipped to reach their own people; multiplication across tribal lines.**

The Team

The team is reaching Nuba peoples both in refugee camps and surrounding areas, where the gospel is taking root in powerful ways. What began with small outreach has multiplied into churches planted in multiple locations, allowing the gospel to spread across several tribes. Local leaders are being raised up, and even schools have started under trees. The gospel is especially impacting young people, with many responding in repentance and faith and stepping into ministry. **PRAY: Strength for the team serving in difficult conditions; continued fruit among youth and new believers; leaders raised up from within each tribe.**
