PRS is the Biblical Practice of Listening to (Reading) the Bible Together.

1 Timothy 4:13 (NIV)

Until I come, devote yourself to the **public reading** of Scripture, to preaching and to teaching.

Listening



Revelation 1:3 (ESV)

Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who **hear**, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near.

Whole Bible



Matthew 4:4 (NKJV)

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by **every word** that proceeds from the mouth of God.'" (Jesus quoting Deut 8:3)

Regularly

Psalm 1:2 (NKJV)

But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates **day and night.**



High Quality

Nehemiah 8:8 (NKJV)

So they **read distinctly** from the book, in the Law of God; and they gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading.



PRS Examples in the Old Testament

Exodus 17:14a (ESV)

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Write this as a memorial in a book and recite it in the ears of Joshua,..."

Exodus 24:7a (ESV)

Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it in the hearing of the people.

Deuteronomy 31:11b (ESV)

You shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

Jeremiah 36:6b (NIV)

Read to the people from the scroll the words of the Lord that you wrote as I dictated.

PRS Examples in the New Testament

Luke 4:16b (NKJV)

And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read.

Acts 15:21 (NIV)

For the law of Moses has been preached in every city from the earliest times and is read in the synagogues on every Sabbath.

Colossians 4:16a (ESV)

And when this letter has been read among you, have it also read in the church of the Laodiceans;...

1 Thessalonians 5:27 (ESV)

I put you under oath before the Lord to have this letter read to all the brothers.

Why Balance OT & NT and Pray Psalms Often?

Hebrews 1:1-2a (NIV)

In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, **but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son,...**

Luke 9:35 (NKJV)

And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, **"This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!"**

Psalms 55:17 (NKJV)

Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, And He shall hear my voice.

Psalms 72:20 (NKJV)

The **prayers** of David the son of Jesse are ended.

Luke 21:36a (NKJV)

Watch therefore, and **pray always...**

John 5:39-40 (NIV)

Malachi 1:6a (ESV)


"A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If then I am a father, where is my honor? And if I am a master, where is my fear? says the Lord of hosts to you."



Set a One or Two-Year Goal.




Use Bible Tracker in the app Home screen.

Training Together, Not Trying Alone.

Luke 6:40 (ESV)

A **disciple** is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is **fully trained** will be like his **teacher**.

2 Timothy 2:2b-6 (NKJV)

Commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

You therefore must endure hardship as a **good soldier of Jesus Christ**.

No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a **soldier**. And also if anyone competes in **athletics**, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules.

The **hardworking farmer** must be first to partake of the crops.

Training Other Faithful Teachers

Matthew 28:19-20 (NKJV)

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even to the end of the age.*" Amen.

2 Timothy 2:1-2 (NKJV)

Step 1. Belong to a PRS Group, Preferably with 1 or 2 Friends



Ecclesiastes 4:12 (NKJV)

Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And **a threefold cord is not quickly broken.**

Luke 4:16 (NKJV)

So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And **as His custom was**, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read.

Step 2. Set a One or Two-Year Goal



Deuteronomy 8:3 (NKJV)

So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that **man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.**

Matthew 4:4 (NKJV)

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by **every word** that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "

Step 3. Track and Share It



Proverbs 27:17 (NIV)

As iron sharpens iron, so **one person sharpens another.**

1 Timothy 4:15 (ESV)

Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that **all may see your progress.**


