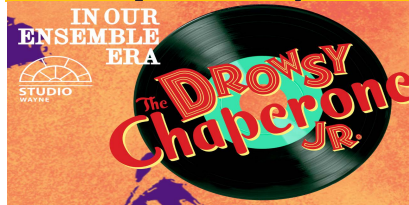
McBeth

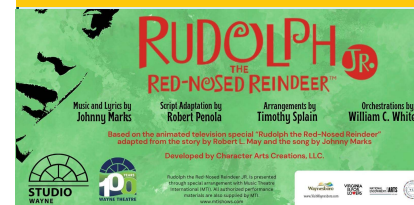

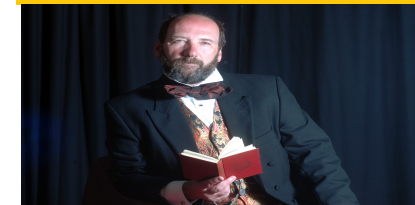

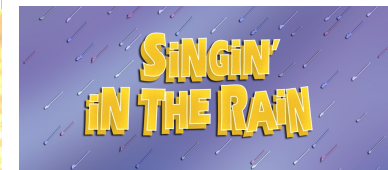
