

Coming to Holy Trinity:

Spires in the Sun

Jonathan Rich and Phil Eschbach, author and photographer of the award-winning book, *Spires in the Sun: The Carpenter Gothic Episcopal Churches of Florida*, will be coming to Holy Trinity on Sunday, May 18 for a talk, meet-and-greet, and book-signing. The event will be held in the parish hall east during the Rector's Forum at 10:20am.

Our Historic Chapel is one of the 39 surviving 19th-century Florida Carpenter Gothic Episcopal churches profiled in Spires in the Sun.

Mr. Rich's talk will describe why and how this unique architectural style came to be sown on the Florida frontier in the 1800s.

Spires in the Sun, winner of the Florida Historical Society's 2024 Charlton

Tebeau Award, weaves together architectural, church, and Florida history in a richly illustrated hardbound volume. Now, in its second printing, the book features vivid color photography, rare black-and-white images from the past, and over 500 pages of stories of the earliest surviving wood-frame Episcopal churches in Florida.

KANUGA RENEWAL CONFERENCE 2025

Located in western North Carolina near the picturesque town of Hendersonville, Kanuga is a Retreat and Conference Center affiliated with the Episcopal Church. In addition to summer camps for children of all ages, Kanuga hosts a number of conferences for adults as well.

One such offering unfolds this coming June 22 - 27. This year's keynote speaker is The Rev. Dr. Rob Sturdy. He will be presenting on being a Christian in a non-Christian 21st century. Rob is the Anglican chaplain to the Corps of Cadets at St. Alban's Chapel at the Citadel, Charleston. Rob teaches in the D. Min. program at Trinity School for Ministry in Ambridge, PA. He is an active participant on the leading edge of international scholarship in the area of historical theology. He is married to Stephanie and they have two children.

Participants from all over the southeast will gather in this relaxed conference atmosphere to hear our keynoter, fellowship with one another, worship in the historic Kanuga chapel, fish or swim in Lake Kanuga and take in the wonderful sites and trails of both the conference site and western North Carolina.
