


# HOLY TRINITY EPISCOPAL CHURCH THE TRIBUNE



#### HONDURAS MISSION PARTNERSHIP

Holy Trinity is exploring an international missions partnership with the Episcopal diocese of Honduras, and San Juan Apostol Episcopal Church and school in Siguatepeque, Honduras.

At the request of Bishop Lloyd Allen of Honduras, Holy Trinity has been invited to explore a partnership with St John's, which also has a day school with just under 100 students. St John's is one of the largest and strongest Episcopal churches in Honduras, and the opportunity is tremendous to come alongside what God is already doing there and partner together for the growth of God's Kingdom in Honduras.

In November, Tom, Daniel and Dave Lacey are making a week-long trip to Honduras to meet the leadership and explore what a next step in the partnership may look like. Our hope would be to take a coalition of parishioners from Holy Trinity sometime in the summer of 2026. Would you pray for us as we go on this exploratory trip this November 5-10?
