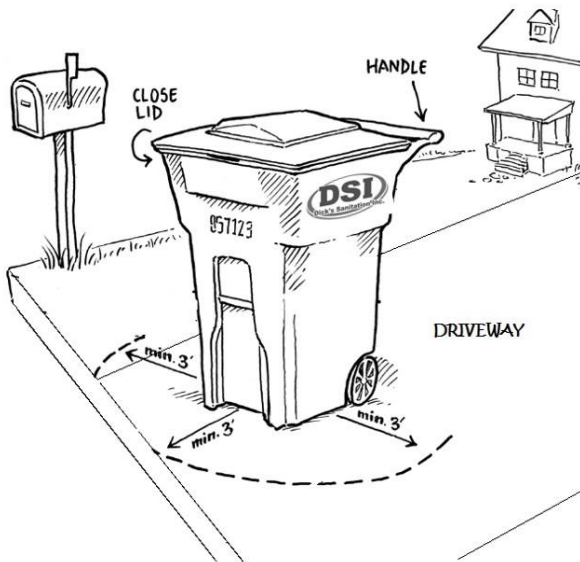

## Cart Placement



To create maximum safety and efficiency, please place your cart(s) no more than 3ft from the street and keep a 3ft clearance from other carts or obstructions such as mailboxes, light posts, utility poles, fire hydrants, low hanging branches, shrubs, or vehicles.

Remember to make sure the handle is facing the residence and there are not overhead obstructions.

**Remember, the cart(s) should be streetside by 7:00am.**

## Yardwaste 2026 Season

The 2026 Yard Waste collection will start the week of April 13<sup>th</sup>  
(Weather Permitting)

### Acceptable Materials:

- Small Branches/Brush
- Grass Clippings
- Leaves
- Garden Waste (old flowers and weeds)



Minnesota state law prohibits mixing brush, trees or yard waste with your household garbage.

### Reminder

Use and fill the yard waste cart first, then set any additional bags/bundles at least 3 feet from the yard waste cart.

If you have additional yard waste material that will not fit in in your container, please contact DSI to schedule and arrange payment.

Additional bags must meet ASTM D6400 standards. This includes both paper bags and biodegradable corn starch bags. Additional bags must weigh under 30 pounds.

Sod, dirt, tree stumps, rocks, lumber, treated wood and straw are just a few of the many items NOT collected with this curbside program.

- Empty, rinse, and replace cap

### Cardboard & Boxes

- Corrugated cardboard
- Paperboard boxes (e.g. cracker boxes)

### Metal Cans

- Aluminum, tin and steel cans

### Plastic

- Soda, juice and water bottles
- Milk and juice jugs
- Margarine, cottage cheese,
- Cream cheese and other tubs and lids
- Laundry detergent bottles and jugs
- Clear berry and produce containers

### Cartons

- Milk, soup, broth, and wine cartons
