WHAT WE'VE BEEN UP TO IN 2024:

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- Our Scholarship Committee selected 15 students to receive our academic scholarship in honor of Issac's 15th birthday.
- These students are being awarded \$30,000 in total for the 2024-2025 school year.

CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

- We sent 11 kids to camp this summer, for a scholarship total of \$4,146.
- Camps kids chose: YMCA Camp, 4-H Camp, Crossings Camp, Fiddlewood Farms Camp Creation, & Connect Camp

OPERATION COMMUNITY CLEANUP

- We had 38 monetary sponsors this year, plus 4 in-kind donors.
- Net sponsorship amount of over \$25,000.
- Over 40 teams and 240 people picked up enough trash to fill 360 full bags, plus 107 items too big for a bag!

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ISAF was awarded the Owensboro Chamber of Commerce Award for Nonprofit of the Year along with The Center, in a group of 21 nominees!
- The First Christian Church Legacy Fund awarded ISAF a \$10,000 grant to go towards the Makerspace we will be creating at the Center for Good Works.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- Nearly 50 ISAF supporters showed up to cheer on runners in the YMCA BBQ 5K.
- We set up a booth at the Pitino Shelter's Comedy Night fundraiser to share our mission and vision with attendees.
- We have sponsored/supported via monetary donation: Shop with a Cop, Goodfellows Club Luke Woodward Tennis Tournament, MentorKids KY Rugged Race + sponsorship of their new building, Nicky Hayden Memorial Foundation, and the Dream Riders Mane Event.
