JULY 2024 - JULY 2025:

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- Our Scholarship Committee selected 16 students to receive our academic scholarship in honor of what would be Issac's 16th birthday this year.
- These students are being awarded \$39,000 in total for the 2025-2026 school year.

CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

- We sent 15 kids to camp this summer, for a scholarship total of \$3,953.
- Camps kids chose: Timber Wolf Lake Young Life Camp, 4-H Camp, Aviation Museum of KY camp, Fiddlewood Farms Camp Creation, & Connect Camp

OPERATION COMMUNITY CLEANUP

- 2025 is the third year for our now annual beautification event.
- We had 35 monetary sponsors this year, plus 3 in-kind donors.
- Net sponsorship amount of \$30,500.
- Over **32 teams** and **772 people volunteered** and picked up enough trash to fill **450 full bags!**
- ISAF visited four local elementary schools to discuss the importance of keeping our community clean, not only for our event, but year round.
- Had more school participation than ever, with one local high school participating with over 140 volunteers.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- ISAF has given presentations to our local Kiwanis Club, Owensboro Garden Club, and local charitable group, 10,000 Reasons.
- Over 50 ISAF supporters showed up to cheer on runners in the YMCA BBQ 5K.
- We have sponsored/supported via monetary donation: Goodfellows Club and Goodfellows Club Luke Woodward Tennis Tournament, MentorKids KY Rugged Race, Nicky Hayden Memorial Foundation, Dream Riders Mane Event, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, John Lanham Jam Day, and Green River Area Down Syndrome Association (GRADSA) Buddy Walk.
- Hosted our first ever "Issac Day" to celebrate the life of Issac with outdoor family fun.

CENTER FOR GOOD WORKS

- Officially joined Peerspace to list our rentable spaces--The Venue at 1010, and our downstairs Recreational and Meeting Space.
- ISAF has hosted numerous events and meetings, with rental funds being used to pour back into our local community.
