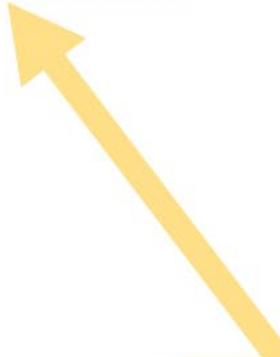

There are 5 account types in ISSA Hub: **Explorer, Student, Instructor, School, Trainer**

Explorer and Student accounts serve the same core function but are intended for users at different stages of their sailing journey.

- The **Student account** is designed for users who are already in contact with a sailing school and know which course they want to join.
- The **Explorer account** is for users who are still considering their options, haven't chosen a course yet, or don't have access to a sailing school in their area.

Registering as an Explorer or Student will suit the needs of most users.

Instructor Account: For users who hold an ISSA Instructor license and actively work as sailing instructors. This account allows them to manage sailing courses within the ISSA Hub.

School Account: Intended for sailing schools that employ ISSA-certified instructors. Schools can create and manage sailing courses in the ISSA Hub.

Trainer Account: Reserved for a select group of users authorized to manage ISSA Instructor training programs.



The fastest way to register an account is through your **social media account**. This **skips the email confirmation** step and takes you directly to selecting your account type.

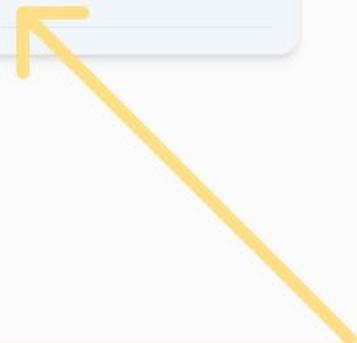

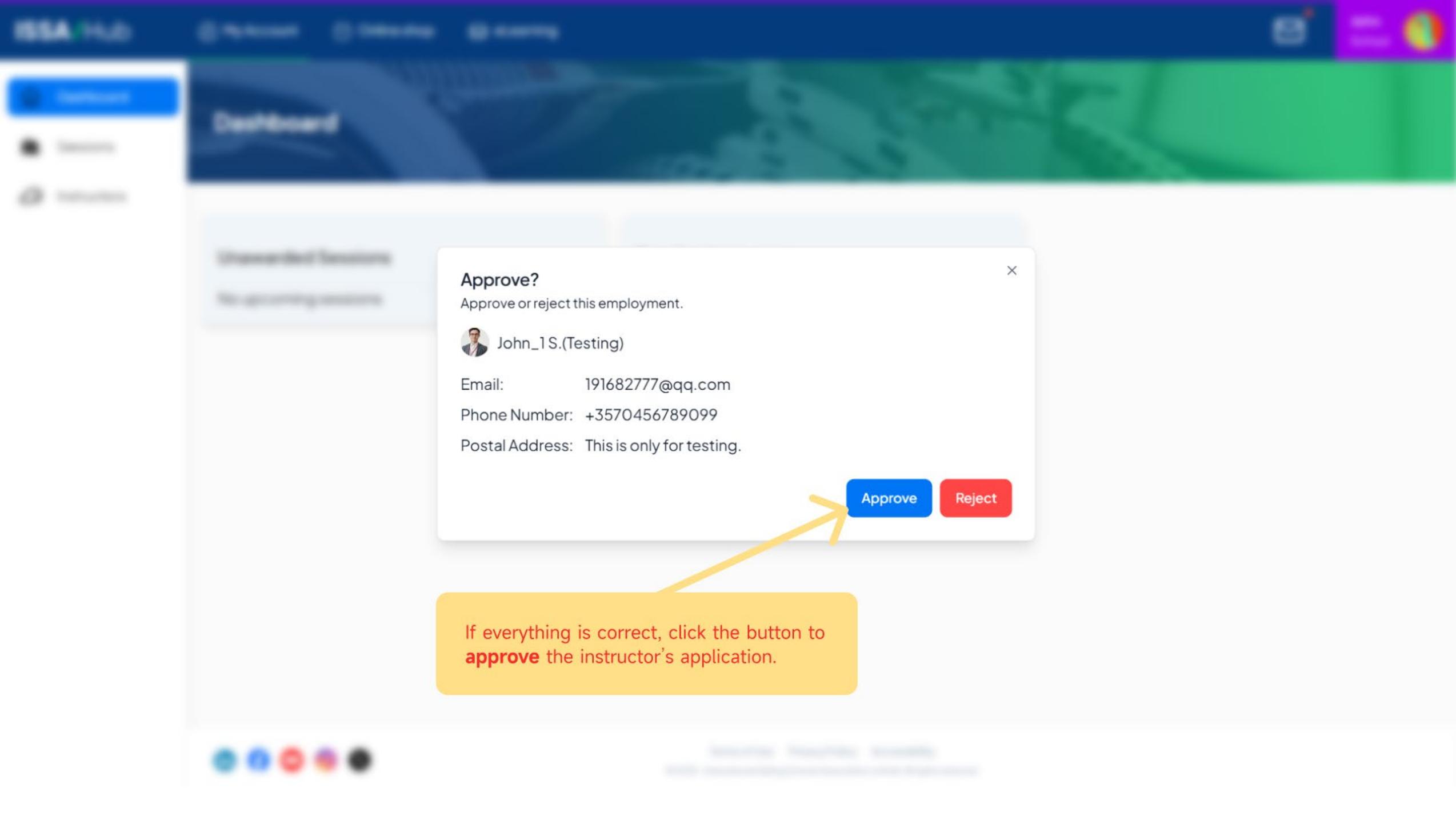

“Choose Primary Instructor”, use this field to assign the main instructor responsible for the course. The system will automatically filter the list, showing only instructors who hold the appropriate ISSA license required to teach this course.

In this example, there are two instructors at the school, but only John_1 is certified as an Advanced Dinghy Instructor. As a result, when selecting a primary instructor for the “Dinghy Level 3” course, only John_1 appears in the list.

“Auxiliary Instructor”, if the primary instructor is unable to complete the course, the school can assign an assistant instructor to cover the remaining sessions. However, the system requires that the auxiliary instructor holds the necessary qualification to teach this course.

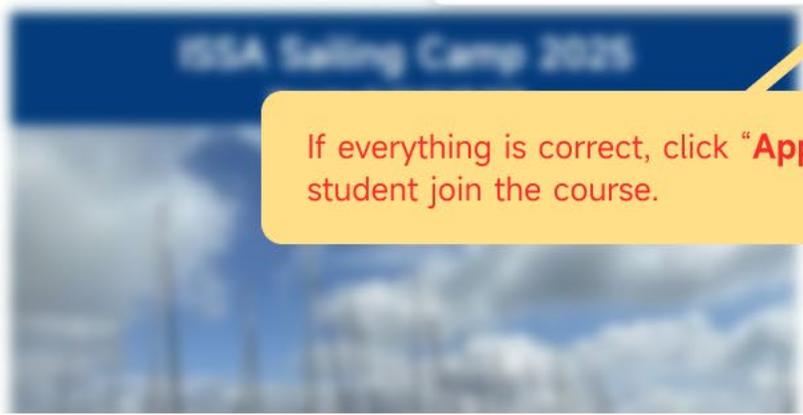

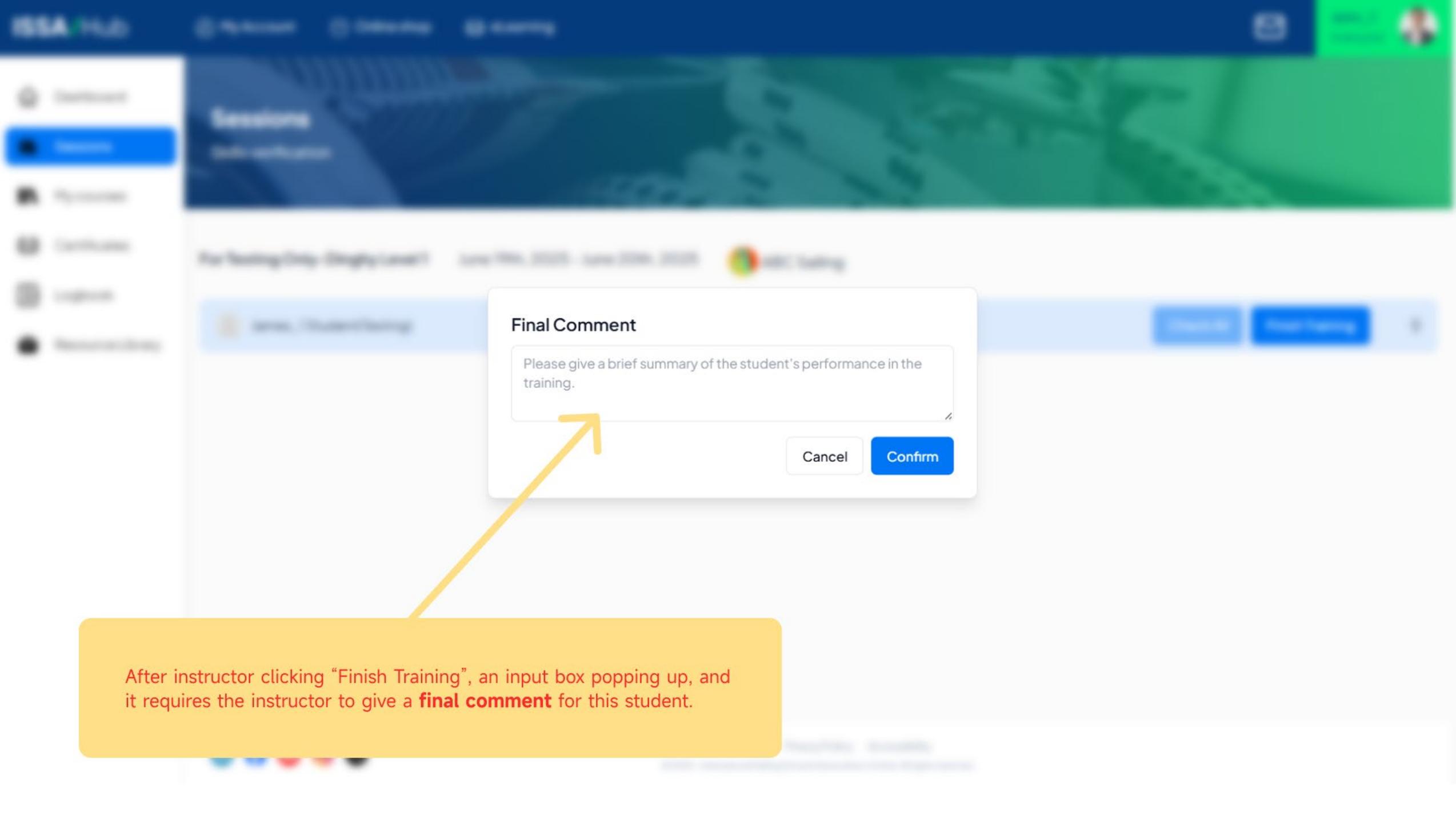

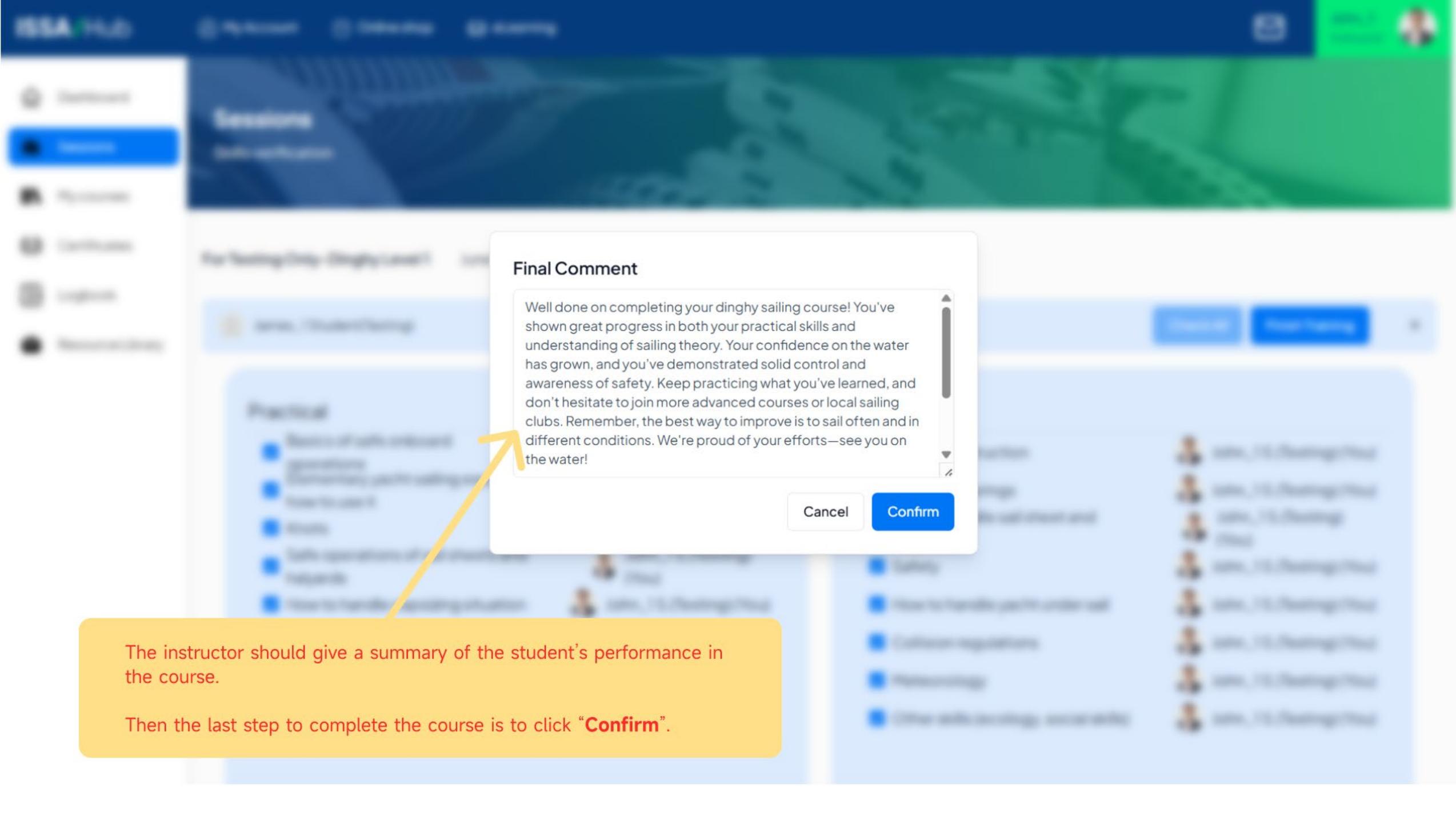
