It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless Canadian Western Horse Association, show committees, organizers, competition, officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives.

I acknowledge that Equestrian Sport and its competitions are a high-risk sport and that I am participating at my own risk and in full knowledge of the hazards and potential hazards which are inherent in this sport. I further acknowledge the inherent risks in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury and even death to both horse and rider which can result from normal use, competition or schooling.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in this event, I hereby assume all risk and I hereby release and absolve Canadian Western Horse Association, show committees, organizers, competition, officials, organizers, agents, volunteers, employees and representatives from all responsibility, liability or claims of any nature and kind which I may have arising from the participation in this activity, including the negligence of one or more of the individuals and organizations referred to herein.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any of the events carried on, sanctioned and/or sponsored by the Dufferin Agricultural Society, Dufferin, Manitoba I shall save harmless & keep indemnified the Dufferin Agricultural Society, Carman, Manitoba, their officers, agents, officials, servants, organizers and representatives from and against all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands whatsoever concerning death, injury, loss or damage to the undersigned whether same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the representatives and each of the last mentioned parties shall be deemed to be a party to this agreement as if Dufferin Agricultural Society, Carman, Manitoba and were acting as each party's agent or trustee. CWHA CARMAN SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All competitors are required to have a Manitoba Horse Council membership for insurance protection
- CWHA 2026 Membership is required. Available at registration or by emailing CWHAhorseshows@gmail.com.
- Signed WAIVER MUST BE HANDED IN PRIOR TO SHOW. Online <https://form.jotform.com/261698708093268>
- Submit entries online at www.carmancountryfair.ca or email registration form and signed waver to lighthouse@dufferinagsociety.com. Pre-registration is REQUIRED. Late registration accepted with penalty. One entry form & registration fee per Exhibitor/Rider combo. Class changes are accepted on show day.
- Full payment must be made by cash or check to show secretary prior to show start. Cash payment is required to add classes after show starts.
- A limited number of box stalls and tie stalls and are available. Stalls must be reserved prior to arrival. Tack stall provided upon request free of charge.
- Show is NERIC approved; proper spelling of horses registered name is required on entry form.
- Payout: 1ST \$20; 2ND \$15; 3RD \$10; 4TH \$5
- Show office opens 1 hour before scheduled show start time.
- Proper show attire/footwear is required. Half chaps and paddock boots accepted for English. Long sleeve shirts required for all western and speed events. All exhibitors under 18 years of age are required to wear CSA approved riding helmet.
- Barns must be cleaned before 8:00 am daily and manure hauled to south end of barns. Stalls must be cleaned prior to departure. Bring your own bedding. Do NOT occupy a vacant stall not ASSIGNED to you.
- Clean up manure behind your horses on grounds, grass and in barns.
- Exhibitor number MUST be visible to be judged. Note that in Showmanship, number must be on your back. While riding, number should be on each side of your saddle pad.
- Classes with 3 or less entries may be combined with another age category where possible.
- Horses competing in W/J classes may be ridden two hands in a snaffle or 1 handed in a shank bit, regardless of age. In W/J/L classes, horses 6 years and older must be shown one-handed in shank bit; English and speed events exempt.
- **No cross entry between same horse being entered in Western Pleasure and in Ranch Rail.**
- **Run-In gate entry is not permitted for speed events.** Arena gates will remain closed during every run.
- If young riders require assistance in the arena with someone near them, other than in lead line, they can compete however they will be placed below any competitors able to exhibit on their own without assistance.
- Unprofessional behavior including foul language, bullying, cruel or inhumane treatment of animals will not be tolerated. Party will be asked to leave the grounds; no refund given.
- All competitors agree to abide by the rules of the show and the Directors of the DAS.
- No refunds unless a Dr. / Vet note for exhibitor or horse is provided.
- Judges' decision is final. The show committee reserves the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions by the show committee will be final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming reasonability for knowledge of the rules and releases show management from any claims or losses.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

- Exhibitors arriving on Thursday and/or Friday **must arrive before 8:00AM** and load-out after 5:00PM. Move in beginning anytime after 10 am Wednesday. If you are unable to arrive or depart during these hours **prior arrangements** need to be made with the DAS office.
- Please note that the parade begins at 10 a.m. Saturday morning and the main streets of Carman will be closed and no access will be allowed into or out of the town. Please plan accordingly.
