On June 21, 1976, Queen Juliana inaugurates the Slotervaart Hospital: as the first municipal hospital.



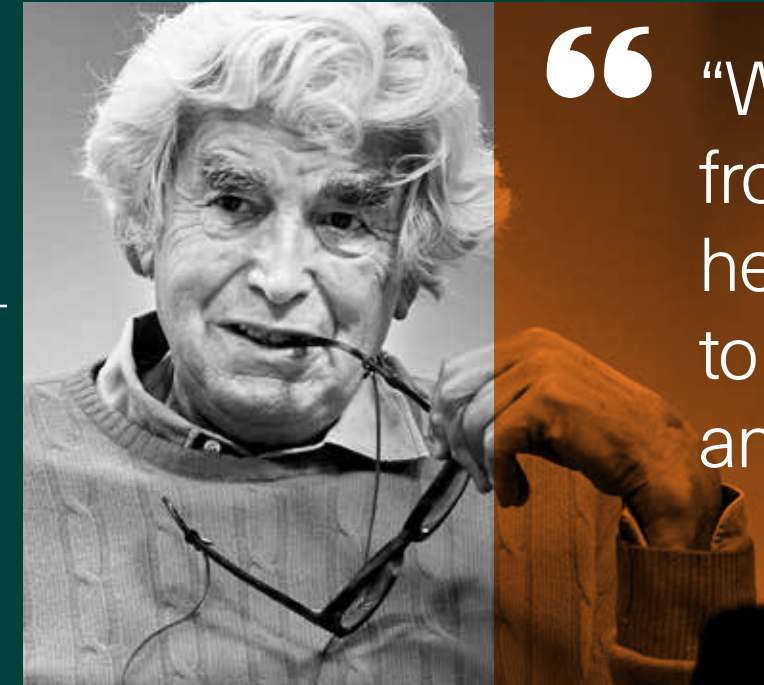
1997 - 2018

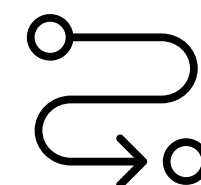
Het Slotervaart offers a generous parking garage with electric vehicle charging stations

Two private phone booths, perfect for calls or concentrated work.



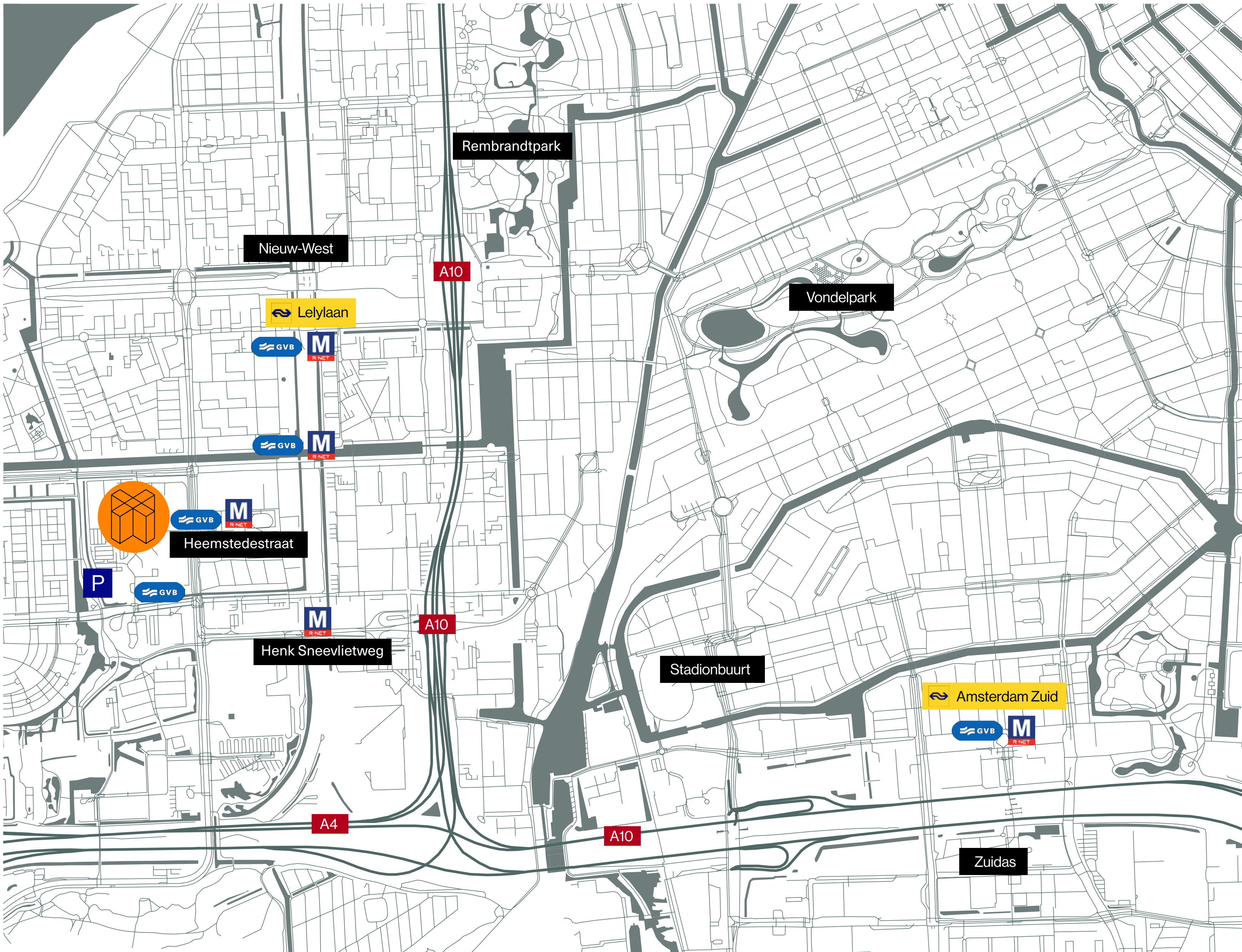

The site where Het Slotervaart is located features a covered parking garage with 2,500 spaces. The garage is accessible 24/7 and equipped with charging points for electric vehicles.

Affordable parking subscriptions are available for tenants, ensuring convenience and accessibility. In addition, there are plenty of bicycle parking spaces on site, supporting sustainable and active mobility.





Innovation district

De Plantijn

Het Slotervaart is part of a new city district within the Schinkelkwartier in Amsterdam Nieuw-West, called De Plantijn. Over the next 15 years, this area will be transformed into a vibrant neighborhood with a mix of residential, offices, healthcare, and abundant amenities. Het Slotervaart, Sanquin, Cordaan, the Antoni van Leeuwenhoek Hospital and the Municipality of Amsterdam are collaborating to bring this vision to life.

The program will be doubled to approximately 450,000 m² GFA, creating a future-proof district with facilities such as restaurants, laboratories, and a supermarket.
