The Australia Day Medallion Program

Each year the RSL participates in the above program and presents Australia Day Medallions to organisations and individuals that have made a significant contribution to the Veteran and Ex-service Community in Western Australia.

The Australia Day Medallions are reserved for the highest level of recognition and provide a unique way of inspiring and recognising individuals or teams when presented in the lead up to Australia Day, 26 January.

Criteria

The criteria for receiving the medallion are outstanding achievements, length of service and recognition in a particular field.

While there is no nomination form as such, nominations are made in the form of an open letter from a Sub-branch outlining the nominee's details, any referees and the way in which a nominee has met the criteria.

In an effort to achieve uniformity RSL WA's Honours & Awards Committee advise that the simple template below should be used when nominating for the Medallion.

The Award is sponsored by the Australia Day Council for presentation on Australia Day and has Australia wide recognition.
