Near-production innovation vehicles: MAN TGE electrified by Flux at IAA Transportation

At IAA Transportation 2026 in Hanover, MAN Truck & Bus is showing two MAN TGE electrified by Flux for the first time - near-production innovation vehicles electrified by the Swiss company Flux. The vehicles target applications that have so far been difficult to cover electrically.

Versatile, powerful, compact: with the broadest model range in the segment - from panel van to single and double cab, across different wheelbases and weight classes - the vehicle covers every application without compromise. Further technical data underlines its competitiveness: the electric all-wheel drive, currently available in this segment only from Flux, and the battery offering the highest capacity in the shortest wheelbase. The 119 kWh NMC battery enables a range of up to 480 km. The technical highlights are rounded off by a payload of up to 2,500 kg and a towing capacity of 3,500 kg. Electric and electromechanical power take-offs delivering up to 56 kW make the vehicle well suited to special applications such as ambulances, fire services and municipal vehicles - areas that have so far been difficult to electrify.

"Everything we have learned since 2021 has gone into this vehicle. It proves that electrification works in the specialised commercial vehicle segment as well, with no compromise on range, traction or payload. It is the most versatile and most powerful vehicle we have ever developed," says Duga Hoti, Executive Chairman at Flux Mobility.

"Our presence at IAA Transportation shows how we are advancing electrification for particularly demanding transport and special applications as well. Our aim is to offer customers practical solutions with a high level of operational capability. Together with our development partner Flux, we will gain valuable insights in Hanover from direct exchange with customers," summarises Daniel Holbein, Head of Business Unit Van at MAN.
