Who is eligible to apply?

- Graduating high school seniors entering into any area of study at a two- or four-year college/university or pursuing a certificate or technical degree at a career or technical school. GPA range of 2.0 or higher.
- Current college students who are pursuing Bachelors' Degrees, Graduate Degrees, certificates, or professional licenses in any field. GPA range of 3.0 or higher.

How do I apply?

- Neatly print or type the application. All attachments must be typed. The application must be signed (digitally or by hand if printed).
- All information given on the application must be true.

- If uploading documents, **please save files as PDFs** and include your name on each document. Transcripts may be uploaded with the application or mailed separately.

- **EARLY SUBMISSION (December 19, 2025)** format is a 500-1000 word essay.
- **REGULAR SUBMISSION (First Friday of March)** format is a 500-1000 word essay.
- Applications, transcripts and references **must be received by** end of business day on the **First Friday of March**. If mailing, please allow for adequate processing and shipping time.
- **Submissions postmarked and received after deadline will not be considered.**

How are winners chosen?

- Applications are reviewed by a neutral selection committee. Decisions made by the LH Ministries Committee are final.
- Selection criteria may include, but are not limited to: GPA, extra-curricular and/or community involvement, career goals and written skills.
- Only scholarship winners will be notified in **April 2026**.

How will I receive scholarship funds?

- In order to receive scholarship proceeds, winner must be registered as a full-time student and submit a class schedule for his or her first semester in college/trade school.
- **Must** participate in the Annual Baccalaureate Service on **May 16, 2026**.

- b. ***"Write the Vision: My 5 Year Plan"*** (Inspired by Habakkuk 2:2. God instructs the prophet Habakkuk to write the vision, and make it plain so that not only the prophet could read it and understand, but all who would be fulfilling it.)

2. Resume- (Please refer to the resume template provided for high school students. **Ensure resume contains Two (2) References and Transcript (GPA 2.0 or higher for high school students ONLY).**)

List two individuals who are willing to evaluate you for a scholarship. They may be teachers, mentors, coaches, or other personal references; however, **at least one reference must be a teacher**. Have each person complete an evaluation form and include with this application (or references may be submitted through email at scholarship@thelordoftheharvest.org).
