- Someone skilled at building positive, respectful relationships with colleagues, setting clear boundaries, and promoting a healthy work vibe.
- Committed to fairness, equality, and creating an inclusive environment where everyone feels welcome.
- Ready to work some evenings and occasional weekends—no surprises, we'll always give you a heads-up.
- All staff and volunteers undergo enhanced DBS checks and follow strict safeguarding rules to keep everyone safe.

- Drive the Youth Club on Wheels (YCOW) and other mobile gear to cool locations where youth sessions happen you're basically the wheels behind the magic.
- Keep the YCOW spotless and in top shape, so it's always ready to roll and impress.
- Make sure all YCOW equipment is cared for and set up perfectly for every youth session.
- Stand up against discrimination whenever and wherever you see it making sure everyone feels safe and respected.
- Pitch in with any other tasks the YCOW Lead needs help with no two days are the same!
- Follow all YCOW policies and guidelines, including health & safety and safeguarding, keeping everyone safe and sound.
