A request to allow the amendment of approved **Surface Mine Permit SMP12-001** to expand the boundaries of the existing Corona Quarry mining operation from approximately 336 acres to 448.6 acres (an increase of 114.9 acres) and the area permissible for mining from 260 acres to 353.6 acres, to occur over six phases, in order to facilitate the continued mining of aggregate; to extend the SMP's expiration for a period of 200 years or until the exhaustion of permitted materials (whichever is longer); to expand the ultimate quantity extraction of aggregate from 400 million tons to 600 million tons, and; to revise the SMP's Reclamation Plan and Development Agreement, in conjunction with the construction of a new, ground-mounted solar array covering 25-acres of land for purpose of supplementing onsite energy demand. The project site comprises 10 lots zoned as either M-3 (Heavy Manufacturing) or M-3 (MR) (Mineral Resource Overlay), located (broadly) north of the Temescal Wash, south of Indiana Avenue, east of Sherborn Street, and west of Brockton Avenue on property APNs 107-070-015, 135-270-002, -003, -005, -006, -009, 278-120-001, 278-130-001, 135-300-005 and 006.
