Defensible Space Inspection Application

PURPOSE

Application is hereby made for a Defensible Space Inspection as required by California Assembly Bill 38 and City of Corona Ordinance No. 3344. On and after July 1, 2021; prior to selling property that is located in a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone and High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFHSZ), within the Corona City Limits also known as Local Responsibility Area (LRA) you will need documentation of a compliant Defensible Space Inspection. Such documentation shall not be provided prior to inspection conducted by Corona Fire Department personnel. Please ensure the property is within the Corona City Limits and is located within a VHFHSZ. If outside Corona City Limits, outside high fire hazard severity zone or are unsure about either, please visit <https://www.fire.ca.gov/dspace/> to verify your location with maps updated fall of 2025 by the state. If property is located within Corona City Limits and the VHFHSZ, please complete the following information, attach any required plans or documents and remit inspection fee(s).
