

## PUBLIC NOTICE

This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Historic Preservation Board will conduct a public hearing in the City Council Chambers at 400 South Vicentia Avenue, on Monday, June 29, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

**MARD2026-0002:** Review of proposed alterations to Historic District HD-005 (City Park), a designated historic district listed on the Corona Register of Historic Resources, as part of the Corona City Park Revitalization Project, located at 930 East Sixth Street.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – Pursuant to Section 15164 of the Guidelines for Implementing the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and Section 8.06 of the City's adopted Local CEQA Guidelines, the City, as the lead agency, has prepared an Addendum to the previously certified Environmental Impact Report for the City of Corona 2020–2040 General Plan (SCH No. 2018081039). The City has determined that the proposed Corona City Park Revitalization Project would not result in new significant environmental impacts, substantially increase the severity of previously identified impacts, or otherwise meet the criteria for preparation of a subsequent or supplemental EIR under Sections 15162(a) and 15163(a) of the State CEQA Guidelines.
