This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct a public hearing in the **Multipurpose Room** of City Hall at 400 S. Vicentia Avenue, on Monday, July 6, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

CUP2025-0003: Conditional Use Permit to establish a new 65-foot-tall wireless telecommunications facility disguised as a pine tree, in conjunction with placement of related ground-mounted equipment, within Kellogg Park located at 1645 Kellogg Avenue.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – Per Section 15303 of the State Guidelines for Implementing the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and Section 3.38 of the City's Local CEQA Guidelines, a Notice of Exemption has been prepared for the project because the project qualifies as a Class 3 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) categorical exemption.
