- Classroom: track if children from a particular classroom are more prone to seeking care for injuries than others
- Injury reported: track the kinds of injuries children are seeking care for
- Involvement of others: determine if the child is seeking care because someone else made a decision for their body (e.g: pushed or lifted the child up to monkey bars), or if the incident is the result of their own choices (e.g: tripped or fell). Circle Yes if someone else contributed to the incident. No if the injury is from their own choices.
- Care provided: Indicate the kind of care the child is seeking (wash station, band-aid or ice pack)
- Return to play: Indicate if the child was willing and able to return to play once their needs were met
- Follow up required: complete full incident or accident report if the child requires medical attention for their injury beyond what the school can provide
