- Classroom: track if children from a particular classroom are more prone to seeking care for injuries than others
- Injury reported: track the kinds of injuries children are seeking care for
- Involvement of others: determine if the child is seeking care because someone else made a decision for their body (e.g. pushed or lifted the child up to monkey bars), or if the incident is the result of their own choices (e.g. tripped or fell). Circle Yes if someone else contributed to the incident. No if the injury is from their own choices.
- Care provided: Indicate the kind of care the child is seeking (wash station, band-aid or ice pack)
- Return to play: Indicate if the child was willing and able to return to play once their needs were met
- Follow up required: complete full incident or accident report if the child requires medical attention for their injury beyond what the school can provide
