How can you participate?

Your child's school will invite you to participate in a group discussion with other parents/guardians. Your participation in this study is voluntary - if you would like to take part in it, let your child's school know.

During the group discussion, we will ask you about your thoughts on outdoor play and learning in schools.

The group discussion will be led by Megan Zeni, a research team member and a teacher in the RSD. It will take approximately 60 minutes.

You will receive a \$50 gift card for your participation.
