Terroir and location

In the heart of the Côte de Beaune, Meursault lies at the foot of the vineyards. Its clay-limestone soils and east-to-south exposure give the wines remarkable balance and elegance.

The parcel from which this wine is produced lies to the east of the village, in the lieu-dit l'Hôpital de Meursault. Its soil is clay and sand based.

Tasting notes

Our Bourgogne Aligoté captivates with its brightness and liveliness. On the nose, it reveals a fruity and floral bouquet with notes of green apple, lemon, and white flowers. On the palate, it delights with crisp acidity and citrus notes, making it a refreshing and expressive wine, perfect to enjoy young.
