Terroir and location

The historic capital of Burgundy wines, Beaune is renowned for its famous Hospices. The vineyards surrounding the town, ideally exposed from east to south, produce wines of depth and personality.

The parcel from which this wine originates lies to the south of the Beaune appellation, near the border with Pommard. It enjoys excellent exposure and clay-limestone soils rich in white marl.

Tasting notes

Beaune-Montrevenots opens with a lively, precise attack, offering beautiful tension that highlights the purity of the fruit. The texture reveals subtle buttery notes and a lingering mineral finish.

Food and wine pairing

Our Beaune Premier Cru Les Montrevenots pairs perfectly with poultry in sauce and delicate-fleshed fish, which it enhances with elegance and freshness. It also complements soft cheeses such as Brie or Camembert.
