2. Extension Classes for Music Theory and Ear Training

Juilliard will offer online, advanced music courses designed to challenge CUSD's high school students and provide them with the skills necessary to excel in Advanced Placement (AP) exams and college-level music programs. These Extension classes in Music Theory and Ear Training are modeled after Juilliard's rigorous curriculum and are taught by Juilliard faculty, ensuring students receive top-tier instruction.

- **Course Offerings**

The courses will cover essential topics, including music notation, harmony, melodic dictation, ear training, and more, with real-world applications designed to deepen musical understanding. These classes also prepare students for college entrance requirements in music programs.

- **Tailored Curriculum**

The curriculum will be designed to challenge students of all levels, whether they are beginners looking to develop fundamental skills or advanced learners preparing for AP exams. Instructors will provide personalized feedback to help each student achieve their fullest potential.

- **Flexible Learning**

These courses are delivered online, allowing students to engage in lessons and complete coursework at their own pace, with the opportunity to connect with their instructors during office hours for additional guidance.
