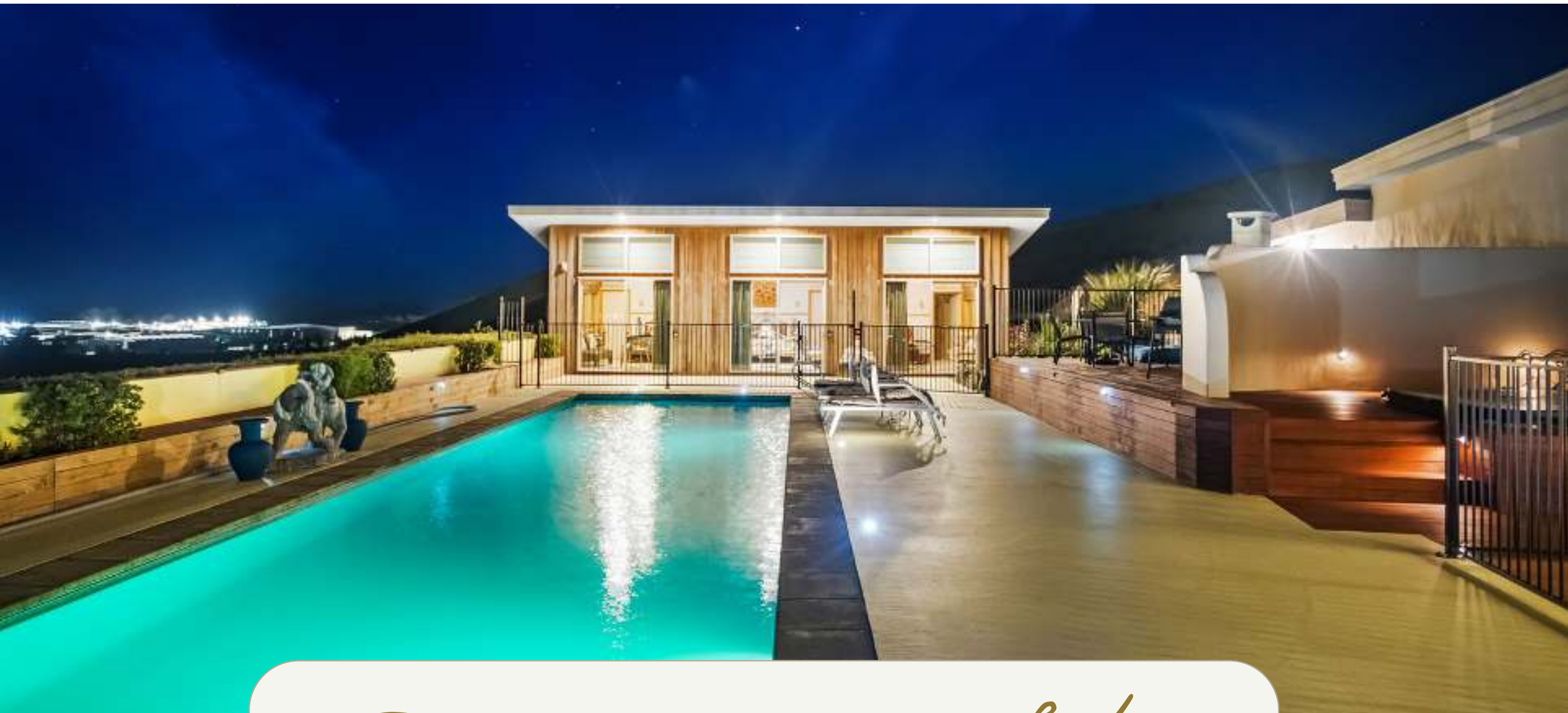
But Beta has a special gift. He somehow knows who the true dog lovers are. If you are one, he will slowly come closer, wagging his tail and introducing himself in his gentle way.

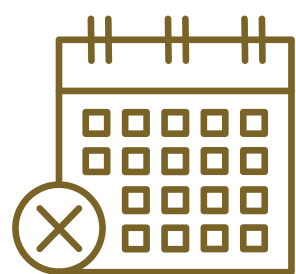
- ❖ We regret that unless the lodge is booked for exclusive use, we are unable to accommodate children under the age of 2 years old.

Plug our address into your GPS. Most GPS apps will take you right to the front door. GPS coordinates available upon request.

**PLANE:** We are approximately 15-20 minute drive from Blenheim airport.

**We offer pick up and/or drop-off from the airport if booked in advance, or any other location, for a fee. We have a 7-seater van and a covered luggage trailer.**

**FERRY:** We are approximately 25-30 minute drive from Picton Ferry Terminal via State Highway 1 south to Blenheim. We can arrange transfers from Picton (at guest's expense).



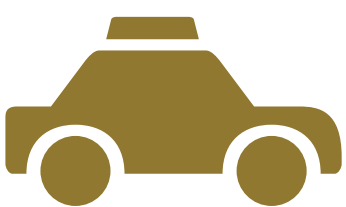

Available at the Airport. We recommend having a car to explore the region. Several rental companies operate in Blenheim

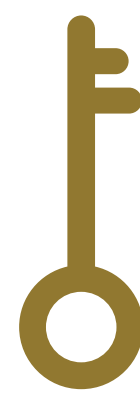

## WAIRAU LAGOONS

📍 Located on State Highway 1, Riverlands.

Most visited historic home in Marlborough. Built in the 1860s using traditional cob construction (mixture of clay, tussock grass, and earth). Beautifully restored by Marlborough Historical Society (1961-1965). Offers fascinating glimpse into early colonial life. Best for:

## POLLARD PARK

📍 55 Parker Street (main entrance)

Blenheim's premier public park spanning 24.6 hectares. Beautiful wooded parkland with meandering stream, formal gardens, golf course. Known as "Marlborough's showcase." Visited by Queen Elizabeth II on February 13, 1963. Best for:

- Families, picnics, gardens, easy walks, photography, duck feeding, relaxation



## EDWIN FOX MARITIME MUSEUM

📍 Dunbar Wharf, Picton

Historic ship museum in Picton featuring the Edwin Fox, world's ninth-oldest surviving ship (built 1853). Only surviving ship from the Crimean War. Fascinating glimpse into maritime and immigration history. Best for:

## KEYS

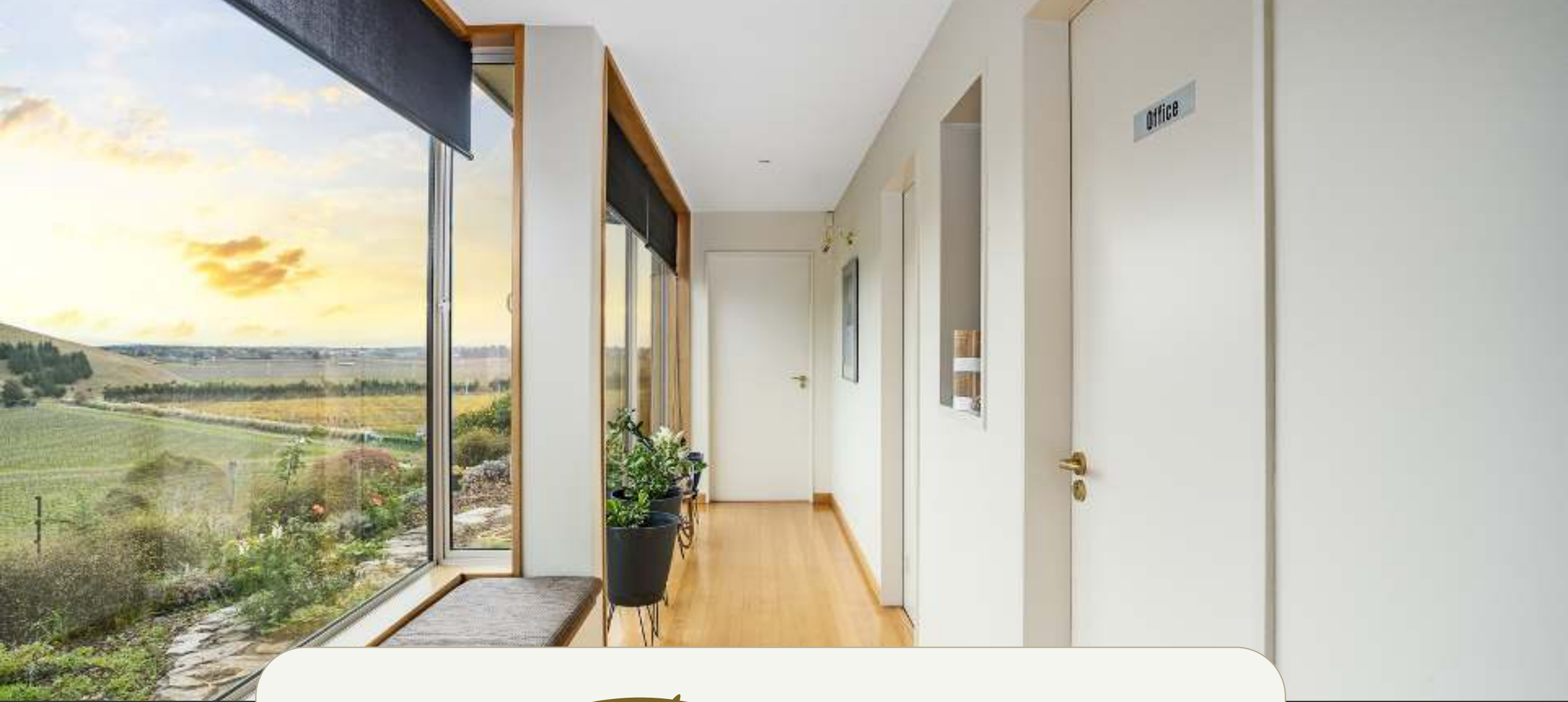
- Leave keys in the room.

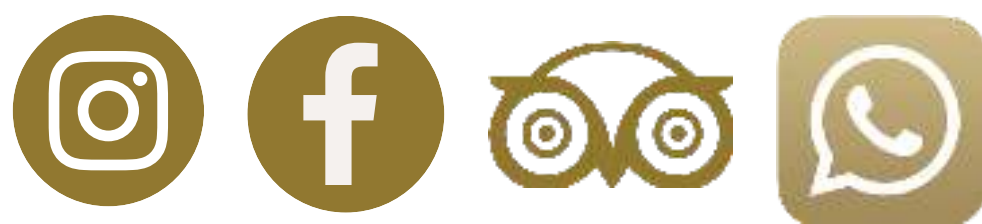
