Don't be fooled. Imposter scams on the rise.

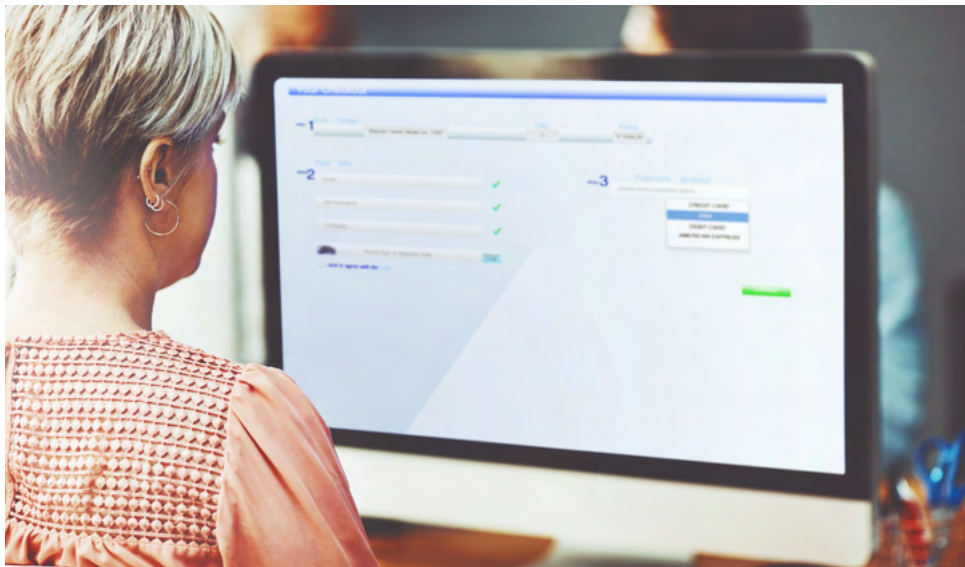

There are many suggestions within the article, but unsolicited calls, emails or texts should be red flags. Demands for you to act immediately, requesting sensitive information along with threats involving fines, late fees, etc. can also be red flags. Stay diligent and be careful!
