Vacancies

Eligibility Criteria

1. **Citizenship:** Candidates must be citizens of India.
2. **Age Criteria:** The candidate must be 20 years to 28 years. Age relaxation is provided to candidates from reserved categories.
3. **Educational Qualifications:** Candidates should have a graduation degree in any discipline from a university recognized by the Central Government. Candidates who are in the final year or semester of their graduation may also apply provisionally.
4. **Computer Literacy:** Operating and working knowledge in computer systems is mandatory.
5. **Language:** Proficiency in the Official Language of the State/UT (candidates should know how to read/ write and speak the Official Language of the State/UT) for which vacancies a candidate wishes to apply is preferable.
