

issuance of call letters, process & pattern of examinations/ Local Language Proficiency Test etc., and ensure that they fulfil the stipulated criteria and follow the prescribed processes.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. **Citizenship**: Candidates must be citizens of India.
- 2. Age Criteria: The candidate must be 20 years to 28 years. Age relaxation is provided to candidates from reserved categories.
- 3. **Educational Qualifications**: Candidates should have a graduation degree in any discipline from a university recognized by the Central Government. Candidates who are in the final year or semester of their graduation may also apply provisionally.
- 4. Local Language Proficiency Test: Provisionally selected candidates not having studied (in class 10th or 12th) any of the specified local language of the State applied, will have to appear in Local Language Proficiency Test (LLPT).

Selection Procedure

The SBI Clerk recruitment process is conducted in three phases:

Phase-I: Preliminary Examination

Phase - II: Main Examination

Phase - III: Local Language Proficiency Test


