



Descriptive paper of only those candidates will be evaluated who qualify in the objective part of main examination.

- ✓ There will be no negative marks in both Prelim and Main exams.
- ✓ Candidate MUST pass in each Section separately and should also obtain minimum marks in the aggregate to qualify for the online examinations (Preliminary and Main) and the interview.
- ✓ Each test will have a separate timing.
- ✓ The minimum marks to be obtained in each Section is mentioned separately above and cut off marks for each section and in the aggregate shall be decided by LIC. Descriptive test of English Language is of qualifying nature and the marks in this test will not be counted for ranking.
- ✓ Maximum Interview marks are 60 and qualifying marks for EWS, Unreserved and OBC candidates are 30. Qualifying marks for SC/ST/PWBD candidates are 27. Candidates who do not obtain the minimum qualifying marks shall be excluded from further selection process. The decision of LIC in this regard shall be final and binding on the candidates and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
