FAQs for Self-Install Projects

▶ What is Dominion Energy's Non-Residential Data Center & Server Room Program?

The Data Server Room Energy Efficiency program is designed to increase savings for data server rooms at dedicated data center buildings, offices, hospitals and healthcare buildings, private universities, large industrial facilities, colocation data centers, cloud-based data centers, modular data centers, and more.

▶ What are the benefits to your facility?

The energy efficiency improvements offer many benefits, including:

- Upgraded equipment reduces energy use, increases reliability, and helps you save on your energy expenses.
- More efficient use of your data server equipment, and HVAC system.
- Financial incentives that help to offset the cost for installing recommended measures.

▶ What is the rebate amount that I will earn?

Qualifying non-residential customers will receive a rebate based on the equipment they install. Eligible measures and rebate information are available at DominionEnergy.com.

▶ What are the measures eligible for self-install?

Customers are able to perform a self-install for any of the eligible measures available through the program. All measures must meet the same qualification and eligibility requirements as those installed by a third-party contractor.

▶ How can I make sure my equipment qualifies for the rebate program?

You can take several steps to verify that products you are planning to install or measures you intend to implement will qualify for the rebate program:

- Submit an eligibility form and initial assessment form prior to purchasing equipment or initiating work. This is required for self-install projects. It will also allow program staff to review your project and equipment information, make you aware of any eligibility issues, and calculate your estimated rebate amount.
- Review general measure eligibility requirements presented on the program measures chart, available at DomSavings.com.
- Discuss your project with program staff. To initiate a project, ask questions, or request additional information, please email NRDataCenter@Honeywell.com.
- All self-install projects will automatically be inspected for Quality Assurance (QA) by Honeywell.
