

Non-Residential Data Server Room Program Incentive Guidelines

Energy Consultation and Audit Incentive Options

▶ **A customer has two options for energy consultation assistance through the Data Server Room Program.**

Option 1: The customer can request an energy consultation performed by program technical staff if they meet the eligibility requirements listed below. The consultation will only consider the data server room area and related equipment. It will also focus on eligible measures from the program measure list.

Option 2: The program will partially reimburse the customer for the cost of a data server room audit conducted by an eligible 3rd party contractor which meets the requirements listed below. The available reimbursement incentive will be calculated as follows:

The audit cost reimbursement will have two components. At a minimum, the customer is eligible for \$1 per square foot of the data server room area. In addition to this, the customer is also eligible for up to \$0.04 per kWh energy savings for measures completed through the program. The maximum potential incentive is 75% of the invoiced study cost or \$8,700, whichever is less.

Energy Consultation Requirements

▶ **In order to be eligible for an energy consultation conducted by program staff, the following criteria must be met:**

- The customer must meet all program eligibility requirements.
- The data server room area must not be new construction and the customer must not have already received an audit or audit cost reimbursement on the same equipment during the 5-year program term.
- The customer must have at least 60kW of Critical IT Load for their data server room area.
- The customer must put forth a good faith effort to consider and implement the measures recommended in the audit report.

▶ **In order to be eligible for the consultation reimbursement incentive, the following criteria must be met:**

- The consultation must be pre-approved, which will verify the customer meets all program eligibility requirements.
- The customer must not have already received a reimbursement on the same equipment during the 5-year program term.
- Measures need to be installed within +/- 12-months for reimbursement.

Audit Requirements

▶ **In order to be eligible for the audit reimbursement incentive, HVAC controls audits should include the following:**

- A description of the existing equipment and system, including any relevant drawings, diagrams, and photos.
- Existing HVAC system type and heating source type (gas, electric resistance, heat pump), HVAC equipment list including fan horsepower, CFM, and setpoint, and connected IT load and description of existing IT equipment.
- If applicable for lighting measures, a lighting survey including lighting type, count, wattage, and hours of operation.
- Facility square footage and data room area square footage.
- A list and explanation of the proposed measures that will result in energy savings.
- The estimated implementation cost for each proposed measure.

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
