If you would like to ensure that your child can participate, please contact us regarding your opportunity to volunteer and help make a difference in our ministry. This year we look forward to:

- **Participating** in special Handbook activities. Some may require your help at home.
- **Participating** in Theme nights (Annual calendar of events provided separately).
- **Singing** songs and **Listening** to counsel from God's Word.
- **Supporting** a Christian Outreach through our Awana fundraising effort. Together, we want to teach our children the importance of giving back to support the spread of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- **Maintaining a Safe and Healthy environment:** Preparing your child(ren) each week to participate safely will be greatly appreciated. Long pants and close-toed shoes ensure safe participation in game time and keeping sick clubbers home will help to ensure everyone stays as healthy as possible.

Our Flat Fee pricing has been adjusted to spread the average cost of each club segment across the number of years a clubber may attend in that group. This fee covers all books, a uniform, a book bag, and the former registration fees. Uniforms and book bags are expected to be reused until graduation to the next club segment. Extra credit books and replacement materials will be charged at itemized rates available at the time of need. We want EVERY child to be able to attend. Please do not let costs deter your child's participation. Limited scholarship funds are available and can be obtained by contacting Jeremy Hascall.
