

## Redmond Family Home

Capturing the essence of family life, this 1980s Redmond home underwent a complete transformation to blend style and function for a family of six. A second-story extension over the garage added a spacious playroom and two new bedrooms, while the rest of the home was refreshed with a refined neutral palette, natural stone accents, and contrasting matte black fixtures. New windows with black interior frames and white exteriors enhance the overall aesthetic.

Upstairs, a previously awkward hallway was reworked for better flow and additional storage. Each children's bathroom was given its own personality—one with a modern farmhouse flair featuring green cabinetry and crisp white tile, the other with bold navy cabinetry and glossy blue accents. The primary bath was redesigned with a double walnut vanity, stone-tiled dual shower, and upgraded linen cabinetry.

The living room's dated brick hearth was replaced with a subtle stone surround, while the adjacent kitchen was fully remodeled with bright cabinetry, a contrasting black island, and matte black details. A widened entry creates a welcoming arrival, leading to a bright sunroom with large picture windows and a new modern fireplace. Under the staircase, a new powder room features a custom live-edge counter, bold wallpaper, and a sleek modern sink.
