

# Fast and Fun Famous Faces

PLAY

A three-round partner game combining elements of charades and guessing games, focusing on identifying famous personalities.



## Learning Intentions

### Enhancing Communication and Descriptive Skills

Students will improve their ability to describe and communicate ideas effectively by using descriptive language, nonverbal cues, and limited-word prompts.

### Fostering Teamwork and Collaboration

Students will develop teamwork skills by working closely with their partner to identify famous personalities, promoting collaboration and mutual support.

### Improving Memory and Quick Thinking

Students will strengthen their memory and quick-thinking abilities as they recall information about famous people and respond rapidly during the game.



## Success Criteria

### Effective Communication and Description

Students successfully describe famous personalities using appropriate language, actions, and a single word, helping their partner identify the person correctly within the time limit.

### Active Participation and Team Collaboration

Students actively engage in each round of the game, working collaboratively with their partner and demonstrating strong teamwork and support.

### Accurate and Quick Identification

Students accurately and quickly identify the famous personalities based on their partner's descriptions, showing an ability to think quickly and recall relevant information

## Objective:

A three-round partner game combining elements of charades and guessing games, focusing on identifying famous personalities.

## Players:

It is best played in groups of eight, forming four pairs.

## Materials:

- Pieces of paper with names of famous people written on them.
- A bowl or hat for the papers.

## Setup:

Each player writes down three names of famous people, totalling 24 names. Papers are scrunched up and placed in a bowl or hat.

## Gameplay:

- **Round One:** One partner describes the famous person without using their name or nickname. Correct guesses earn points.
- **Round Two:** Partners swap roles. This round involves acting without words.
- **Round Three:** Players swap back, and the describer can only use one word.
- Each round lasts 30 seconds per pair, with points awarded for correct guesses.

## Winning the Game:

The pair with the most points across all rounds wins.

## Variations:

- Adapt the game for educational purposes by changing the category from famous people to academic topics.
