# Double Dice 0 – 100

## Objective:

Dice 0 – 100 is a fast-paced, exciting game that blends luck, speed, and strategy using six-sided dice. The aim is for the first family member to successfully write the numbers 1 through 100 in order by grabbing the pen whenever doubles are rolled.

## Players:

Ideal for groups of 4 or 5 players, but easily adaptable for larger or smaller family groups.

## Materials:

- Two six-sided dice per player.
- A pen for each player (or one shared pen that is passed around).
- A sheet of paper with a dedicated section for each player's number sequence.
- Names written at the top of each section.

## Setup:

- Allocate a section of the paper for each family member to write their number sequence and write each person's name at the top.
- Provide each player with two six-sided dice.
- Ensure everyone understands the rules and is ready for a fun, fast-paced session.

## Gameplay:

### • Start:

On a chosen signal, all players start rolling their dice simultaneously.

### • Rolling Doubles:

When a family member rolls doubles, they shout "Double!" and quickly grab the pen to start (or continue) writing the number sequence, beginning with 1 if starting out.

### • Taking Turns:

While one player is writing, the others continue rolling, waiting for their chance. When another player rolls doubles, the pen is passed over to them so they can add the next number in their sequence.

### • Writing Numbers:

Only the player holding the pen is allowed to write numbers. They must stop immediately when another player rolls doubles, allowing that player to take their turn.

### • Fast-Paced Action:

The game continues in a rapid, lively manner, with everyone rolling dice and seizing the chance to write numbers.

### • Winning the Game:

The first player to complete writing the number 100 under their name wins the game.

## Variations for Different Settings:
