## Family Objects

## Objective:

Roll Emoji Bingo is a pair activity designed to spark self-reflection and family conversation using emojis as conversation starters. The goal is to create a line of five marked squares on the bingo grid by rolling dice and sharing personal reflections.

## Players:

Ideal for playing in pairs. Multiple pairs can play simultaneously, making it a great activity for larger family gatherings.

## Materials:

- A printed PDF sheet featuring an emoji bingo grid for each pair.
- Two six-sided dice per pair.
- A pen or marker for marking the grid.

## Setup:

Each pair of family members receives an emoji bingo sheet, two dice, and a writing instrument. Find a comfortable space where everyone can sit together and chat.

## Gameplay:

### • Rolling the Dice:

Family members take turns rolling both dice. The number on the first die indicates the vertical position on the grid, and the number on the second die indicates the horizontal position.

### • Emoji Reflection:

The dice reveal an emoji at the intersection on the grid. The player then reflects on a time in the past six months when they experienced an emotion that matches the emoji and shares their story with their partner.

### • Marking the Grid:

After sharing, the player marks that square on the grid with their initials. If a roll lands on a square that's already been marked, the turn is forfeited.

### • Continuing the Game:

The game continues with players taking turns until one player creates a complete line of five marked squares (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally).

### • Winning the Game:

The first player to form a line of five initials in a row on their bingo grid is the winner.
