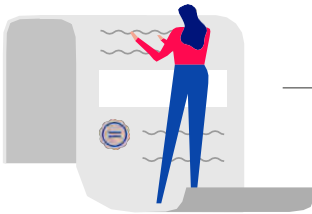

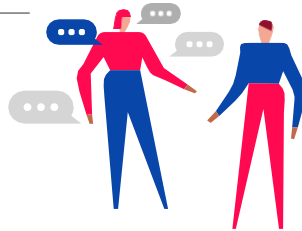

# GET TO KNOW LAW

# Introduction

Law is an incredibly varied subject that affects every aspect of human life, right down to the air we breathe. It affects our relationships with each other, the state and other countries. It affects our education, employment, travel, property, health and human rights. The law industry is competitive and changes in line with social needs. A law degree offers diverse career pathways and a skillset to help you succeed in almost any career.



## Course Organisation

Typically, an LLB degree lasts 3 years. Students can opt for an additional year of placement or study abroad, which takes place in the third year of study.

Modules are taught through lectures, small group tutorials and seminars. Assessments will depend on the modules, with compulsory subjects typically being assessed in examinations, supplemented by written essays and elective modules by combination of those moots and other exercises.

# Course Content

To satisfy the requirements of the UK Bar Council, these 7 modules are compulsory. To be eligible to sit for Malaysian CLP, students must have completed modules 1-6.

## Compulsory Subjects

To meet the requirements for the Bar Professional Training Course, a degree must be at least two-thirds study time in Law subjects, and **must include the following 7 subjects:**

1. **Contract Law:** Deals with agreements courts will enforce
2. **Criminal Law:** Deals with acts prohibited by the law
3. **Land Law [Property Law]:** Deals with interests a person may have in land from leases, to ownership, rights of way
4. **Equity & Trusts:** Trusts means the title of a property is held by one for the benefit of others. Equity is a branch of law evolved to mitigate rigidity of common law.
5. **Tort:** A civil wrong rising out of an action which independent of a contract, an action for damages may be brought
6. **Constitutional Law:** Legal working and relationship between the Crown, Parliament, Civil Service, Police, Courts and Citizens
7. **European Union Law:** Deals with the laws of the European Union and how it affects the law in the UK

# APPLYING FOR LAW

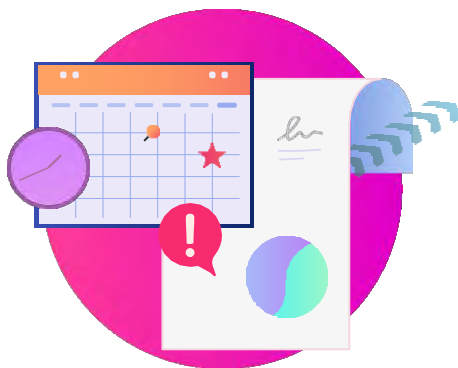
## How it works

Applications for undergraduate degrees for most of the UK universities go via UCAS. You will need to register and complete the UCAS form, with payment, by the set deadline. Colleges will usually set internal deadlines for their students. With the exception of Oxford and Cambridge, the UCAS deadline for competitive universities is January 14, 2026.

The final deadline of UCAS application is June 30.

A number of universities will ask for LNAT, and these are:

- b. University of Cambridge
- c. Durham University
- d. University of Glasgow
- e. King's College London
- f. The London School of Economics and Political Science
- g. The University of Nottingham
- h. University of Oxford

## Entry Requirements

Universities are happy to accept 3 A-Level subjects or a combination of 3 HL and 3 SL IB subjects from Arts, Humanities, Maths and Sciences. General Studies and Critical Thinking are not accepted.

## Selectors' Attitude

Your UCAS application is always considered as a whole; taking into account your qualifications, experience, personal statement and reference.

Some universities will ask for LNAT, and the result can determine the outcome of your application.

## Personal Statement

Applicants with enthusiasm in reading, debating, with informed interests in the current affairs of the world are highly desirable. Evidence of prior visits to law firms, courts and internship experience are also encouraged.

# LOOKING AHEAD

## Career Path

Two common pathways (CLP & BPTC), to qualifying as a lawyer, are illustrated in the following diagram:



Having completed the BPTC / CLP, a person must then spend 9 months as a pupil in Chamber under the guidance of an advocate.

After that, the person may be *Called to the Bar* as an advocate and solicitor.

In the UK, there is another route to qualifying as a lawyer via the Legal Practice Course (LPC), which is a one-year course. This together with two years training in a UK law firm will then enable you to qualify as a solicitor. While this route to qualifying is recognised in Malaysia, securing a two-year training contract in the UK, after the LPC, is very competitive and one would only be eligible to chamber in Malaysia, having completed the training in the UK.

**\*NOTE: This Guide includes only universities whose initial 3-year LLB law degree is recognised by the Malaysian and UK Professional Law Organisations so that you can continue to become a lawyer.**

Within the Malaysian context, there are two common pathways for the education and training of a person intending to qualify as a lawyer through a UK degree.

**\*\*NOTE: This refers to current qualifying procedures.**

## Pathway 1: CLP Route

**STEP 1** - Obtain a **recognised** UK Honours degree in Law in the UK.

*(The 30 law degrees which are recognised by the Legal Profession Qualifying Board in Malaysia, have their university's name shaded in the **Course Codes & Fees** section that begin from page 6 of this booklet.)*

**STEP 2** - Pass the examination for the **Certificate of Legal Practice (CLP)** in Malaysia

**STEP 3** - Passed, or be exempted from, the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination.

Other requirements with regard to qualifications, imposed by the Legal Profession Qualifying Board in Malaysia, in order to sit the CLP for all students graduating after 1 October 1998, include:

- At least 3 credits at SPM, or its equivalent, obtained in one and the same examination
- At least 2 principal passes at STPM, or its equivalent, in one and the same examination, taken at the end of a course whose duration is at least one academic year.
- A law degree which has a minimum of three years of study, or at least eighty weeks of lectures if less than three years, and which contains twelve subjects, including the following compulsory core subjects – law of contract; law of torts; constitutional law; criminal law; land law; equity and trusts



## Pathway 2: BPTC Route

**STEP 1** - Obtain a 1st or 2nd Class Honours from an accredited LLB in the UK.

**STEP 2** - Pass the Bar Professional Training Course (BPTC) in the UK.

**STEP 3** - Passed, or be exempted from, the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination.

Bar Professional Training Course (BPTC) is available full-time through the following:

BPP Law School Leeds / BPP Law School London / BPP Law School Manchester / BPP Law School Birmingham / Nottingham Law School / Cardiff Law School / The City Law School / The University of Law-Birmingham / The University of Law-London / The University of Law-Leeds / Manchester Metropolitan University / Northumbria University / Bristol UWE.
